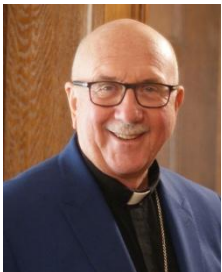

## ONLINE CHAIR YOGA CLASS

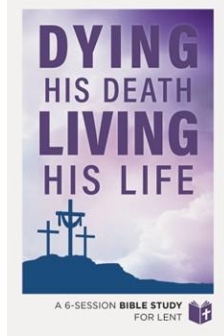
