

We can ask ourselves these kinds of questions, from time to time, examining our commitment to God, especially in this Lenten season.


- Do we give only the minimum of our time, talent, and treasure to God?

All of the things we have in our lives, (possessions, money, health, careers, etc) are all temporary gifts to us, on loan from God, until we see him face to face in eternal life. 




