pray God's blessings on Ruskin and his parents and godparents.




# **The Eternal Light** is given by **Jim Gnad in memory of all grandmothers.**

Stewardship - Did You Know?

A "New Creed" may have been uncovered, this is it:

Jesus lived during the time of Tiberius Caeser. He lived a virtuous life. He was a wonder worker. He had a brother named James. He was thought to be the messiah. He was crucified under Pontius Pilate, on the eve of the Jewish Passover. Darkness and an earthquake occurred when he died. His disciples believed that he rose from the dead. They were wilfing to die as well, for their beliefs. Christianity spread rapidly, as far as Rome. His disciples denied the Roman Gods and worshipped Jesus as God.

Sounds great, like one of the three Creeds, but with one big difference. Not one of the above statements come from the new or old testaments. They are in fact, not from any Judeo-Christian source at all. They come from the following historians:

Tacitus 55-126 AD, Josephus 37-100 AD, Suetonius 69-12 AD, Celius 2nd century, Thallux 2nd century, Lucian mid 2nd century, Pliny the Younger 61-113 AD, Phlegon mid 2nd century, Mara Bar Serapion mid 2nd century.

Note: None of these writers were believers, nor followers of Jesus. In fact, they all dis-liked or hated Christians or anyone or anything, having to do with him. This does although make them un-biased and reliable in their writings. They wrote the facts as they were seen and heard. What these writers did do, was to help prove to the world what they themselves denied - the truth about the life, death and resurrection of Jesus. We, as believers do this by believing in Jesus by Faith, Scripture, and historical writings.
