

OPENING PRAYER

SECOND READING: 2 Timothy 1:1-14

¹ Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God, for the sake of the promise of life that is in Christ Jesus.

²To Timothy, my beloved child: Grace, mercy, and peace from God the Father and Christ Jesus our Lord.

³ I am grateful to God—whom I worship with a clear conscience, as my ancestors did—when I remember you constantly in my prayers night and day. ⁴ Recalling your tears, I long to see you so that I may be filled with joy. ⁵ I am reminded of your sincere faith, a faith that lived first in your grandmother Lois and your mother Eunice and now, I am sure, lives in you. ⁶ For this reason I remind you to rekindle the gift of God that is within you through the laying on of my hands, ⁷ for God did not give us a spirit of cowardice but rather a spirit of power and of love and of self-discipline.

⁸ Do not be ashamed, then, of the testimony about our Lord or of me his prisoner, but join with me in suffering for the gospel, in the power of God, ⁹ who saved us and called us with a holy calling, not according to our works but according to his own purpose and grace, and this grace was given to us in Christ Jesus before the ages began, ¹⁰ but it has now been revealed through the appearing of our Savior Jesus Christ, who abolished death and brought life and immortality to light through the gospel. ¹¹ For this gospel I was appointed a herald and an apostle and a teacher, ¹² and for this reason I suffer as I do. But I am not ashamed, for I know the one in whom I have put my trust, and I am sure that he is able to guard until that day the deposit I have entrusted to him. ¹³ Hold to the standard of sound teaching that you have heard from me, in the faith and love that are in Christ Jesus. ¹⁴ Guard the good deposit entrusted to you, with the help of the Holy Spirit living in us.

RITE OF BAPTISM

In baptism our gracious heavenly Father frees us from sin and death by joining us to the death and resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ. We are born children of a fallen humanity; by water and the Holy Spirit we are reborn children of God and made members of the Church, the Body of Christ. Living with Christ and in the communion of saints, we grow in faith, love, and obedience to the will of God.

Sponsors present the candidate:

Pastor: How is your child named?

The presiding minister addresses parents:

Pastor: Called by the Holy Spirit, trusting in the grace and love of God, do you

desire to have Bella baptized into Christ?

Parents: I do

Pastor: As you bring Bella to receive the gift of baptism, you are entrusted with

responsibilities: to live with Bella among God's faithful people, place in her hands the Holy Scriptures, encourage her toward the faithful reception of the Lord's Supper, teach her the Lord's Prayer, the Creed, and the Ten Commandments, pray for her and support her ongoing instruction and nurture in the Christian faith so that Bella may learn to trust God, proclaim Christ through word and deed, care for others and the world God made,

and work for justice and peace.

Pastor: Do you promise to help Bella grow in the Christian faith and life? I do.

Pastor: Sponsors, do you promise to assist Krysten and Jonathan and nurture

Bella in the Christian faith as you are empowered by God's Spirit, and to

help her live in the covenant of baptism and in communion with the Church?

I do.

Pastor: People of God, do you promise to support Bella Rose and pray for her new life

in Christ? We do.

PROCLAMATION

The Lord be with you.

And also with you.

We give you thanks, O God, for in the beginning your Spirit moved over the waters and by your Word you created the world, calling forth life in which you took delight. Through the waters of the flood you delivered Noah and his family, and through the sea you led your people Israel from slavery into freedom. At the river your Son was baptized by John and anointed with the Holy Spirit. By the baptism of Jesus' death and resurrection you set us free from the power of sin and death and raise us up to live in you.

Pour out your Holy Spirit, the power of your living Word, that those who are washed in the waters of baptism may be given new life. To you be given honor and praise through Jesus Christ our Lord, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, now and forever. **Amen.**

PROFESSION OF FAITH

Do you renounce the devil, all his works, and all his ways and do you renounce those forces, powers of the world, and sin that defy and rebel against God and draw us away from him?

Yes, I renounce them.

With the whole Church, let us confess our faith. Do you believe in God the Father? I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth.

Do you believe in Jesus Christ, the Son of God?

I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord. He was conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit and born of the virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended into hell. On the third day he rose again. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again to judge the living and the dead.

Do you believe in God the Holy Spirit?

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.

HOLY BAPTISM

Pastor: Bella Rose, I baptize you in the name of the Father, and of the

Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen

Bella Rose, child of God, you have been sealed by the Holy Spirit and marked with the \pm Cross of Christ forever. Let us pray. The almighty God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has given you the new birth of water and of the Spirit and has forgiven you all your sins strengthen you with his grace to life everlasting.

Receive this white garment to show that you have been clothed with the robe of Christ's righteousness that covers all your sin. So shall you stand without fear before the judgment seat of Christ to receive the inheritance prepared for you from the foundation of the world.

Receive this burning light. Jesus said, I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will have the light of life. Let your light so shine before others that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.

In Holy Baptism God the Father has made you a member of his Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, and heir with us of all the treasures of heaven in the one holy catholic and apostolic Church.
