We, M/s Vishakha Harbola & Associates, Company Secretaries, having registered office situated at New Delhi at K-40, Second Floor, B.K. Dutt Colony, Near Jor Bagh, New Delhi – 110003, were appointed as Scrutinizer by the Board of Directors of M/s. Fortune International Limited (the Company) for the purpose of scrutinizing e-voting process (remote e-voting) and voting by postal ballot at the AGM pursuant to Section 108 and 110 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule 20 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 (Amendment Rules, 2015) and Regulation 44 of SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 in respect of the below mentioned resolutions proposed at the 43rd (Forty-Third) AGM of the Equity Shareholders of the Company scheduled on Tuesday, the 30th Day of September, 2025 at 10:00 A.M. at Amarai Farms, Khasra No. 375, Village- Kapashera, near Police Chowki, Old Delhi-Gurgaon Road, Kapashera, New Delhi – 110037 and, submit our report as under:

1. The compliance with the provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 and the Rules made thereunder relating to voting through electronic means (by remote e-voting) and voting by postal ballot by the shareholders on the resolutions proposed in notice of the 43rd (Forty-Third) AGM of the Company is the responsibility of the Management. Our responsibility as a scrutinizer is to ensure that the voting process both through electronic means and by postal ballot at the meeting are conducted in a fair and transparent manner and render consolidated Scrutinizer's Report of the total votes cast in favour or against if any, to the Chairman on the resolutions, based on the reports generated from the electronic voting system provided by National Securities Depository Limited (NSDL) and the report generated physically for voting by postal ballot at the meeting.



- 2. In accordance with the Notice of the 43rd (Forty-Third) AGM sent to the shareholders and the 'Advertisement' and 'corrigendum' published pursuant to Rule 20 (4) (v) of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 (Amendment Rules 2015) dated 12th August, 2016 respectively, the remote e-voting opened at 09:00 A.M. on 27th September, 2025 and remained open till 5:00 P.M on 29th September, 2025.
- **3.** The Equity Shareholders holding shares as on 23rd September, 2025, were entitled to vote on the resolutions stated in the Notice of the 43rd AGM of the Company.
- **4.** The votes were scrutinized for the purpose of eliminating duplicate voting i.e. on remote e-voting as well as by postal ballot.
- 5. The locked ballot box was subsequently opened at around 10:45 AM on 30th September, 2025, after conclusion of voting at the AGM in the presence of two witnesses who were not the employees of the Company and the e-voting results/ list of equity shareholders who have voted for and against were downloaded from the e-voting website of National Securities Depository Limited (NSDL) (www.evoting.nsdl.com) and the same will be handed over to the Chairman.
