The guilty will be thrown into the lake of fire – hell.


"The Lord is not slow about His promise, as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not wishing for any to perish but for all to come to repentance." (2 Pet 3:9)


#### Jesus Saves

## The Good News

Jesus doesn't want you to spend eternity burning in hell. He loves you so much that He paid the price for your sin by dying on a cross.<sup>5</sup> God wants you to accept His invitation to be saved from your sin by obeying the gospel<sup>6</sup> and then learning to love.

Sin destroys relationships and separates you from God for all eternity. Jesus described hell as the outer darkness<sup>1</sup> and furnace of fire where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth,<sup>2</sup> where the worm never dies and the fire is not quenched.<sup>3</sup> Sinners will go away into eternal punishment, but the righteous into eternal life.<sup>4</sup>

"The Lord's hand is not so short that it cannot save; nor is His ear so dull that it cannot hear. But your iniquities have made a separation between you and your God, and your sins have hidden His face from you so that He does not hear." (Isaiah 59:1-2)
