


What does it do

- The GCC Program receives GHG emission-reduction projects from the entire world. Issues carbon credits and ARECs.
- GCC Program provides opportunity to projects from organisations to choose the outcome they want:
- Reduce green House Gases to catalyse climate action on the ground (minimum requirement)
- Ensures that project construction and operations do not cause any net-harm to the environment and society
- Contribute to the United Nations Sustainable **Development Goals**
- Prevent double counting by receiving host country letter of assurance to prevent and independently verify application of corresponding adjustment
- Comply with CORSIA requirements


- GCC Program received full Approval:
 - Pilot Phase: 23 March 2021
 - Eligible for all types credits, except AFLOU and CCS
 - Verified GCC Credits (generated for vintage 1 Jan 2016 – 31 Dec 2020) are eligible to be used by International Airlines for offsetting their emissions during the Pilot phase (2021-2023) of CORSIA
 - First Phase: Nov 2024
 - Verified GCC Credits (generated for vintage 1 Jan 2021–31 Dec 2026) are eligible to be used by International Airlines for offsetting their emissions during the First phase (2024-2026) of CORSIA






