01 -- SURVIVAL ENGLISH

01 Survival English -- Daily Work Situations

الانجليزية الاساسية للمواقف اليومية في العمل

These phrases keep you functional in any English-speaking professional environment. Study them until they are automatic. They cover misunderstandings, overload, disagreements, buying time, and creating records.

-- CLARIFYING + CONFIRMING --

"Could you say that again? I want to make sure I get it right."

هل يمكنك إعادة ذلك؟ أريد أن أتأكد من فهمي الصحيح.

SURVIVAL

Asking for repetition without seeming lost

ZOOM

"Let me make sure I understand -- you're saying that...?"

دعني أتأكد من فهمي -- تقصد أن...؟

SURVIVAL

Confirming understanding before acting on it

"Just to confirm -- we agreed on X, and I'll deliver Y by Z. Correct?"

للتأكيد فقط -- اتفقنا على X وسأسلم Y بحلول Z. صحيح؟

SURVIVAL

End of any agreement -- creates a written record

EMAIL

"I want to make sure we're aligned before I proceed."

أريد التأكد من اتفاقنا قبل المضي قدماً.

SURVIVAL

Protects you from "that's not what I asked for"

FREELANCE

"I think we might be talking past each other -- let me reframe."

أعتقد أننا قد لا نتحدث عن نفس الشيء -- دعني أعيد الصياغة.

SURVIVAL

Defusing miscommunication before it escalates

ZOOM

"Could you give me an example of what you mean?"

هل يمكنك إعطائي مثالاً على ما تقصده؟

SURVIVAL

When abstract instructions are unclear

-- BUYING TIME WITHOUT LOOKING UNPREPARED --

"I'll circle back on this -- give me a moment to look into it."

سأعود إلى هذا -- أعطني لحظة للنظر فيه.

SURVIVAL

Buying time without saying "I don't know"

EMAIL

"That's a good question -- let me think on it and get back to you."

هذا سؤال جيد -- دعني أفكر فيه وأعود إليك.

SURVIVAL

Stalls gracefully in a live conversation

ZOOM

"I don't have that number off the top of my head -- I'll confirm and follow up."

لا أتذكر هذا الرقم الآن -- سأؤكد وأتابع معك.

SURVIVAL

Not knowing a fact without damaging credibility

"Let me park that and come back to it -- I want to give it the attention it deserves."

دعني أضع هذا جانباً والعودة إليه -- أريد أن أعطيه الاهتمام الذي يستحقه.

SURVIVAL

Deferring a complex topic without dismissing it

ZOOM

"I'll need a little more context before I can give you a useful answer."

سأحتاج إلى مزيد من السياق لأعطيك إجابة مفيدة.

SURVIVAL

Asking for more info before committing to anything

FREELANCE

"I want to give you an accurate answer rather than a fast one."

أريد أن أعطيك إجابة دقيقة وليس سريعة.

SURVIVAL

Signals care over speed -- strong professional framing

-- MANAGING WORKLOAD + CAPACITY --

"Happy to take that on -- what's the timeline and priority level?"

يسعدني تولي ذلك -- ما هو الإطار الزمني ومستوى الأولوية؟

SURVIVAL

Accepting a task while setting clear expectations

"I'm slightly over capacity right now -- can we revisit this next week?"

طاقتي الحالية ممتلئة قليلاً الآن -- هل يمكننا مراجعة هذا الأسبوع القادم؟

SURVIVAL

Saying "I'm overloaded" without complaining

"I want to flag something before it becomes a problem."

أريد الإشارة إلى شيء قبل أن يصبح مشكلة.

SURVIVAL

Early warning -- always better than late surprise

ZOOM

"If I take this on, something else will have to move -- can we decide together what gets deprioritised?"

إذا تولّيت هذا، فسيتم نقل شيء آخر -- هل يمكننا تحديد ما يتم تأجيله معاً؟

SURVIVAL

Pushes workload decisions back to the manager

01 -- SURVIVAL ENGLISH (CONT.)

-- SECTION 01 CONTINUED --

-- DISAGREEING WITHOUT DAMAGING THE RELATIONSHIP --

"I want to push back on this a little -- hear me out."

أريد الاعتراض على هذا قليلاً -- استمع إليّ.

SURVIVAL

Disagreeing confidently without being aggressive

ZOOM

"That is a fair point -- and I'd like to add another angle."

هذه نقطة وجيهة -- وأودّ إضافة زاوية أخرى.

SURVIVAL

Acknowledges their point before redirecting

"I see it differently -- can I share why?"

أرى الأمر بشكل مختلف -- هل يمكنني مشاركة السبب؟

SURVIVAL

Frames disagreement as a question -- disarms defensiveness

"I'm not sure that's the right direction -- here's my concern."

لست متأكدًا أن هذا هو الاتجاه الصحيح -- هذا هو قلقي.

SURVIVAL

Leads with concern not accusation

"That's an interesting way to frame it -- can I offer a different perspective?"

هذه طريقة مثيرة لطرح الأمر -- هل يمكنني تقديم منظور مختلف؟

SURVIVAL

Universal softener -- works everywhere, every time

DEFENSIVE

"I hear you -- and I still have some reservations I'd like to voice."

أسمعك -- ولا يزال لديّ بعض التحفظات التي أودّ التعبير عنها.

SURVIVAL

Acknowledges without surrendering

-- CREATING RECORDS + CLOSING CONVERSATIONS --

"Just to recap what we agreed on -- I'll send this over as a written summary."

فقط لأستعرض ما اتفقنا عليه -- سأرسل هذا كملخص مكتوب.

SURVIVAL

End of meeting -- creates a paper trail automatically

ZOOM

"I'll send a quick summary of what we discussed and the action items."

سأرسل ملخصاً سريعاً لما ناقشناه وبنود العمل.

SURVIVAL

Habit that builds trust faster than anything else

EMAIL

"I'll need written confirmation before I move forward."

سأحتاج إلى تأكيد كتابي قبل المضي قدماً.

SURVIVAL

Never proceed on verbal alone -- non-negotiable

FREELANCE

"Could we schedule some time to go over this together?"

هل يمكننا تحديد وقت لمراجعة هذا معاً؟

SURVIVAL

Requesting a meeting without sounding demanding

EMAIL

-- ASKING FOR HELP + FEEDBACK --

"I'd love your input on this before I finalise."

أودّ الحصول على رأيك قبل أن أنهى هذا.

SURVIVAL

Inviting feedback -- builds trust with collaborators

EMAIL

"Can I get your honest take on this?"

هل يمكنني الحصول على رأيك الصريح في هذا؟

SURVIVAL

"Honest" signals you actually want real feedback

"I may have missed something -- can you point me to it?"

ربما فاتني شيء -- هل يمكنك توجيهي إليه؟

SURVIVAL

Admitting a gap gracefully -- shows self-awareness

"I want to be upfront about something that might be a concern."

أريد أن أكون صريحاً بشأن شيء قد يكون مصدر قلق.

SURVIVAL

Opening a difficult conversation honestly

FREELANCE

"Any feedback on this would genuinely help me improve."

أي ملاحظات على هذا ستساعدني حقاً على التحسن.

SURVIVAL

Asking for critique in a way people want to give

DISCORD

"Is there anything I could have done better here?"

هل هناك أي شيء كان يمكنني فعله بشكل أفضل هنا؟

SURVIVAL

Post-project reflection -- builds long-term relationships

FREELANCE

-- WORKPLACE SMALL TALK (OFTEN UNDERESTIMATED) --

"How's your week looking?"

كيف يبدو أسبوعك؟

SURVIVAL

The simplest, most natural opener for any call

ZOOM

"I'll let you get back to it -- thanks for your time."

سأتركك تعود لعملك -- شكراً على وقتك.

SURVIVAL

Closing a conversation respectfully

ZOOM

"Likewise -- really enjoyed this conversation."

"Looking forward to working together on this."

02 -- DEFENSIVE ENGLISH

02 Defensive English -- Interviews, Pressure + Verbal Attacks

الانجليزية الدفاعية -- المقابلات والضغط والهجمات اللفظية

Each card shows the attack, trap, or pressure question on top -- and the exact counter-move below. The goal is not to be defensive. The goal is to absorb, reframe, and redirect. Study both sides of every card.

-- BIAS + LOCATION ATTACKS --

Attack: "Your English doesn't seem strong enough for this role."

هجوم: " يبدو أن انجليزتك ليست قوية بما يكفي لهذه الوظيفة."

Counter: "I appreciate the directness. I communicate clearly in writing, I'm a strong async collaborator, and my results speak for themselves -- would you like to see examples?"

Turns language bias into a portfolio opening

INTERVIEW

Attack: "We have never hired anyone from Gaza before."

هجوم: " لم نوظف أحداً من غزة من قبل."

Counter: "That means I get to set the standard. I'm fully remote-ready, have delivered across time zones, and I'm the kind of hire that raises the bar for everyone who follows."

Reframes "first time" as an advantage, not a risk

INTERVIEW

Attack: "Are you even reachable given the situation there?"

هجوم: " هل أنت قابل للوصول في ظل الأوضاع هناك؟"

Counter: "I've been delivering client work consistently under genuine pressure for [X period]. My track record shows I don't miss deadlines -- I can send you references who will confirm that."

Responds with evidence, not emotion

INTERVIEW

Attack: "Can you work our timezone?" (passive exclusion)

إقصاء ضمني: " هل يمكنك العمل في توقيتنا الزمني؟"

Counter: "I have a 4-hour overlap with EST and a proven async track record. Many of the best remote teams run intentionally async -- do you already have distributed team members?"

Normalises async, flips the question back

INTERVIEW

ZOOM

-- EXPERIENCE + SENIORITY CHALLENGES --

Attack: "We were expecting someone more senior."

هجوم: " كنا نتوقع شخصاً أكثر خبرة."

Counter: "I understand. What specifically were you looking for? I want to either address it directly -- or be honest with you about whether this is the right fit."

Forces them to name the gap -- you control the next move

INTERVIEW

Attack: "Your background has some gaps."

هجوم: " يوجد بعض الفجوات في خلفيتك المهنية."

Counter: "Those gaps were periods of intense self-directed learning and project work. Let me show you what I built during that time -- it is more relevant to this role than what is on paper."

Reframes absence as hidden action

INTERVIEW

Attack: "Why should we take a chance on you?"

هجوم: " لماذا يجب أن نخاطر بتوظيفك؟"

Counter: "Because I don't come to work to be comfortable -- I come to solve problems. Here is a specific example of a hard problem I have solved that your team is likely facing right now..."

Pivots immediately to proof, not defensiveness

INTERVIEW

Attack: "This is a very demanding role -- are you sure you can handle it?"

هجوم: " هذا الدور صعب جداً -- هل أنت متأكد أنك قادر عليه؟"

Counter: "I have been operating under genuine pressure for years. Demanding is where I do my best work. What specifically concerns you -- let's address it directly."

Shows composure under the attack itself

INTERVIEW

-- RATE + VALUE CHALLENGES --

Attack: "Your rate is too high for someone at your level."

هجوم: " معدلك مرتفع جداً مقارنة بمستواك."

Counter: "My rate reflects my output, not my years of experience. Let me walk you through what I have delivered and what it was worth to previous clients -- then you judge."

Shifts frame from seniority to ROI

INTERVIEW

FREELANCE

Attack: "We have many strong candidates -- what makes you different?"

ضغط: " لدينا كثير من المرشحين الأقوياء -- ما الذي يميزك؟"

Counter: "I don't know your other candidates. I know that I understand this role, I have solved this exact problem before, and I will be here at 11pm if the project needs it."

Sidesteps comparison, anchors to reliability

INTERVIEW

02 -- DEFENSIVE (CONT.)

-- SECTION 02 CONTINUED --

-- CLASSIC INTERVIEW TRAPS --

Trap: "Where do you see yourself in 5 years?"

فخ: "أين ترى نفسك بعد 5 سنوات؟"

Counter: "Doing excellent work I am proud of, with a team that takes quality seriously. Titles matter less to me than impact. What does growth actually look like for this role?"

Refuses the trap, redirects to their answer

INTERVIEW

Trap: "What is your biggest weakness?"

فخ: "ما هو أكبر نقاط ضعفك؟"

Counter: "I tend to over-prepare -- it is hard for me to submit work I'm not satisfied with. I've learned to balance that with deadlines, but my standards stay high."

Turns a weakness into a disguised strength

INTERVIEW

Trap: "Tell me about a time you failed."

ضغط: "أخبرني عن مرة فشلت فيها."

Counter: "Once I underestimated a project scope and missed a deadline by three days. I owned it immediately, communicated early, and rebuilt the client's trust. They re-hired me the next month."

Shows accountability + recovery -- the only good answer

INTERVIEW

Trap: "How do you handle conflict with a colleague?"

فخ: "كيف تتعامل مع الخلاف مع زميل؟"

Counter: "I address it directly and early -- not passive aggressively and not in a group setting. I name the issue, ask for their view, and look for the outcome that serves the project."

Shows maturity, not conflict avoidance

INTERVIEW

Trap: "Tell me about yourself." (many give a CV recitation)

فخ: "أخبرني عن نفسك." (معظم الناس يسردون سيرتهم الذاتية)

Counter: "I solve [X type of problem] for [Y type of organisation]. Most recently I [specific result]. I'm here because this role seems like the exact type of challenge I do best."

Problem-solver framing -- not a biography

INTERVIEW

Trap: "Why do you want to work here?" (many give generic answers)

فخ: "لماذا تريد العمل هنا؟"

Counter: "Because of [specific thing you actually researched -- a project, a product decision, a public statement by the team]. That told me this team thinks carefully about [X], which is rare."

Specificity signals you are genuinely interested

INTERVIEW

Trap: "What is your current salary?" (used to anchor low)

فخ: "ما هو راتبك الحالي؟"

Counter: "I'd rather focus on the value I bring to this role than anchor to past numbers. What is the budgeted range for this position?"

Refuses the anchor, redirects to their budget

INTERVIEW

Trap: "Do you have any questions for us?"

فرصة: "هل لديك أي أسئلة لنا؟"

Best questions: "What does success look like in this role at 90 days?" / "What is the biggest challenge the team is facing right now?" / "Why is this role open?"

Your questions reveal your thinking -- make them count

INTERVIEW

-- UNIVERSAL REFRAME PHRASES (USE ANYWHERE) --

"I want to make sure I'm answering the right question -- is this what you're really asking?"

محايد: "أريد التأكد من أنني أجيب على السؤال الصحيح -- هل هذا ما تقصده فعلاً؟"

Use when: A question feels like a trick or contains a hidden assumption. Forces them to show their hand before you answer.

Exposes the real question behind any trap

DEFENSIVE

"I appreciate you raising that -- let me address it directly."

محايد: "أقدر طرحك لهذا -- دعني أتناوله مباشرة."

Use when: A concern or criticism lands mid-interview. Shows confidence and maturity rather than defensiveness or panic.

DEFENSIVE

Neutralises hostility before you respond

SURVIVAL

"Before I answer -- can I ask what's driving that question?"

محايد: "قبل أن أجيب -- هل يمكنك أن أسأل ما الذي يدفع هذا السؤال؟"

Use when: A question seems loaded or unfair. Understanding the concern lets you answer what they actually need to hear.

DEFENSIVE

The single most powerful defensive phrase

INTERVIEW

"I don't have a perfect answer for that -- but here is how I would approach finding one."

محايد: "ليس لديّ إجابة مثالية على ذلك -- لكن هذه هي طريقي في إيجادها."

Use when: You genuinely do not know the answer. Shows thinking process over knowledge -- which is what senior interviewers actually want to see.

INTERVIEW

Honesty + structured thinking beats bluffing every time

03 Networking + Outreach -- Discord, LinkedIn, Reddit, Cold Email

التواصل المهني والتواصل الخارجي -- عبر المنصات

Every professional relationship starts with a single sentence. These phrases open doors without desperation, add value before asking, and close conversations without awkwardness. Platform tags show where each phrase lands best.

-- OPENING A CONVERSATION (WARM OUTREACH) --

"I saw your comment on X -- that's exactly the problem I've been thinking about."

رأيت تعليقك على X -- هذا تماماً المشكلة التي كنت أفكر فيها.

LINKEDIN

Best cold opener ever -- specific is memorable

DISCORD

"I've been following your work for a while -- the X project really stood out."

أتابع عملك منذ فترة -- مشروع X برز بشكل خاص.

LINKEDIN

Shows you did research -- instantly separates you

EMAIL

"I'm not here to pitch -- I genuinely wanted to connect with someone doing X well."

لست هنا للترويج -- أردت حقاً التواصل مع شخص يتقن X.

LINKEDIN

Disarms the "what do you want?" reflex immediately

DISCORD

"I've been lurking in this community for a while -- genuinely impressive group of people."

أتابع هذا المجتمع منذ فترة -- مجموعة رائعة من الناس حقاً.

DISCORD

First post opener -- acknowledge before asking anything

REDDIT

"Your post about X got me thinking -- I have a related question if you have a moment."

منشورك عن X جعلني أفكر -- لدي سؤال مرتبط إذا كان لديك لحظة.

LINKEDIN

Frames the ask as flowing from their own content

"I found something useful and thought of you -- no ask, just sharing."

وجدت شيئاً مفيداً وتذكرتك -- لا طلب، مجرد مشاركة.

DISCORD

REDDIT

Leading with value -- the most underrated strategy

LINKEDIN

-- MAKING ASKS WITHOUT DESPERATION --

"Mind if I pick your brain on this for 15 minutes? Async is totally fine."

هل تمنح مشاركتي رأيك لـ 15 دقيقة؟ التواصل غير المترامن جيد تماماً.

LINKEDIN

"Async is fine" removes timezone friction instantly

EMAIL

"Do you happen to know anyone hiring for X? I'll return the favour."

هل تعرف بالصدفة أحداً يوظف في X؟ سأبادلك الجميل.

LINKEDIN

Referral request with reciprocity -- much higher reply rate

DISCORD

"I noticed you're hiring for X -- I think I can help, and here's the specific reason why."

لاحظت أنكم تبحثون عن X -- أعتقد أنني أستطيع المساعدة، وهذا هو السبب المحدد.

EMAIL

Cold pitch -- specificity is everything

LINKEDIN

"Would love to collaborate if you ever have overflow work -- no urgency."

أودّ التعاون معك إذا كان لديك عمل إضافي -- لا استعجال.

LINKEDIN

Partner framing -- "work with me" not "hire me"

DISCORD

"I'll be honest -- I'm actively looking and would love to stay on your radar."

سأكون صريحاً -- أبحث بنشاط وأودّ البقاء في دائرة اهتمامك.

LINKEDIN

Direct but dignified availability signal

EMAIL

"No pressure at all -- just wanted to put this on your radar."

لا ضغط على الإطلاق -- أردت فقط إعلامك بهذا.

LINKEDIN

Closes any pitch gracefully -- removes all obligation

EMAIL

-- COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT (DISCORD + REDDIT) --

"Dropping this here in case it helps -- no ask attached."

REDDIT

Community goodwill -- the most underrated strategy

"That's a great point -- building on that..."

هذه نقطة رائعة -- وبالتوسع فيها...

Engaging discussions to build visibility organically

"Here's a quick win you can use right now -- no email signup, no catch."

إليك فائدة سريعة يمكنك تطبيقها الآن -- بدون اشتراك أو شروط.

REDDIT

Leading with pure value before any personal ask

"I've been answering questions in this space for a while -- feel free to DM if you need help with X."

أجيب على الأسئلة في هذا المجال منذ فترة -- لا تتردد في مراسلتي إذا احتجت مساعدة في X.

DISCORD

REDDIT

Positioning yourself as a resource before a seller

"Feel free to check out my portfolio -- built it specifically to show [X type of work]."

تفضل بالاطلاع على معرض أعمالي -- بنيت خصيصاً لإظهار [نوع X من العمل].

DISCORD

REDDIT

Sharing work without sounding like you're selling

"Any feedback on this would be gold -- I'm specifically trying to improve X."

أي ملاحظات على هذا ستكون ذهباً -- أحاول تحديداً تحسين X.

DISCORD

REDDIT

Asking for critique -- specific ask gets specific answers

-- LOCATION + REMOTE IDENTITY --

"I'm based in Gaza -- fully remote, GMT+3, and I have delivered for clients in 6 countries."

أقيم في غزة -- عمل عن بعد بالكامل، GMT+3، وقد عملت مع عملاء في 6 دول.

EMAIL

REDDIT

Own your location -- turn geography into a proof point

"Remote-first is how I do my best work -- I have years of evidence to back that up."

العمل عن بعد هو الطريقة التي أقدم فيها أفضل عملي -- لديّ سنوات من الأدلة لدعم ذلك.

NETWORK

EMAIL

Frames remote as a feature, not a compromise

"I work best async -- my timezone is GMT+3 and I deliver ahead of schedule."

أعمل بأفضل شكل بصورة غير مترامنة -- توقيتني GMT+3 وأسلم قبل الموعد المحدد.

EMAIL

GENERAL

Pre-empting timezone concerns professionally

"My portfolio has been built under real constraints -- which means every piece earned its place."

NETWORK

EMAIL

Reframes adversity as proof of quality

-- FOLLOWING UP WITHOUT BECOMING ANNOYING --

"Just circling back -- completely understand if now isn't the right time."

أتابع فقط -- أفهم تماماً إذا لم يكن الوقت مناسباً الآن.

EMAIL

LINKEDIN

Second follow-up -- removes guilt from non-response

"One last nudge -- after this I'll leave it with you."

متابعة أخيرة -- بعد هذا سأتركها لك.

Third follow-up -- signals you respect their time

EMAIL

"Let me know if anything changes on your end -- happy to reconnect then."

أخبرني إذا تغير أي شيء من جانبك -- يسعدني التواصل في ذلك الحين.

Final graceful exit that keeps the door open

"Sharing something new I built -- thought it might be relevant given what you mentioned."

أشارك شيئاً جديداً بنيت -- اعتقدت أنه قد يكون ذا صلة بما ذكرته.

LINKEDIN

EMAIL

Value-based follow-up -- never just "checking in"

04 Freelance Client Management -- Getting, Keeping + Protecting

إدارة العملاء المستقلين -- الاستقطاب والحفاظ والحماية

Freelancing is a business, not a job application. These phrases help you close clients, set rates, handle scope creep, deliver bad news professionally, protect your boundaries, and exit gracefully when needed.

-- SCOPING + QUOTING --

"Before I give you a number, I'd like to understand the full scope -- can you walk me through it?"

قبل أن أقدم رقماً، أودّ فهم النطاق الكامل -- هل يمكنك توضيحه لي؟

Never quote until you fully understand the job

FREELANCE

"My rate for this scope is X. I can adjust deliverables to fit your budget -- what matters most to you?"

معدلي لهذا النطاق هو X. يمكنني تعديل المخرجات لتناسب ميزانيتك -- ما الأهم بالنسبة لك؟

Anchors rate while staying flexible -- adjust scope, not rate

FREELANCE

"Happy to start with a small paid test project -- that way we both see how we work together."

يسعدني البدء بمشروع اختباري مدفوع صغير -- حتى نرى كلانا كيف نعمل معاً.

Low-risk entry for hesitant new clients

FREELANCE

"I'll put together a brief scope of work for us to agree on before I start."

سأعد ملخصاً موجزاً للنطاق لنوافق عليه قبل البدء.

Always document scope. Always.

FREELANCE

"I don't negotiate my rate -- but I can adjust what's included at this price."
