President's Report

- The club has had an extremely successful year with registrations. Increase in numbers has meant most teams were closed-off well prior to season due to maximum playing list numbers.
 523 playing members.
- For a number of teams next season, we will need to offer positions to 2017 players first, then opening up the team on a first come-first served basis. This will require parents to register and pay early. It is a problem, but can be seen as a nice problem to have.
- Finals are looking good for nearly all of our youth teams.

- Jumpers

Club supplier SportsPower Mandurah arranged jumpers for us this year. Sizing was an issue even though we gave them our old jumpers. It is more of a design fault and they have asked if we could use them again next season and they will have the jumper redesigned to our requirements. The Committee will consider the matter further.

Good Sports Level 3

Level 3 Good Sports maintained this year. Good Sports accreditation is about creating a safe and family-friendly environment and being mindful of alcohol and smoking at junior sport. We want to be THE club of choice in the Peel, and continue to work towards providing the best game day environment for the kids.

- Look to install "No Smoking" signs around verandah as we should be a smoke-free ground during Juniors.

Ocean Rd and Northport Oval

- Northport to be developed for junior games. Cost \$120K and we have committed \$10k. Green space for training remains a factor in carefully managing the growth of team numbers more Friday training.
- Next season we will again look at a no pay-no play policy from round 1 to avoid the extra work in chasing money. It worked well this season.
- Major financial sponsors thanked Will look to renew these sponsorships and seek new/additional sponsors this year.
- Even Team Policy Junior Club Manual states that "In the event that a club enters more than one team in the same age group division, players must be allocated to the team so that they are evenly matched". This is checked by the JCC at games. Auskick to year 3 process is to grade players so they are evenly matched in year 3 teams. Other teams in the one division should be evenly matched. Club and Coaches need to work together to ensure this happens.
- Finals Majority of youth team to play finals. Finals meeting to be announced.
- Next year Coaches and Managers If you have already agreed to volunteer as a Manager or Coach next season, the Club thanks you once again for your invaluable support and for supporting our community youth. If you are unable to do so, then thank you for your past support and hopefully your continued support as a general member. If you aren't continuing, we would also like to ask you to please advise your team tomorrow at your end of game presentation, and perhaps ask the parent group to please volunteer for next season. You could follow this up at the wind-up trophy presentations. Gives them an opportunity to ask questions.

Treasurers Report

- The current financial statement was tabled and discussed
- The club started the season with approximately \$35,000 in the bank, and with an expected profit this year of around \$16,000 we forecast that we should have \$51,000 in our account by season end. We are still expecting \$26,000 of expenses before season end, with \$6,000 still due in from windups. Budget spreadsheet tabled at meeting.
- Major expenditure \$10k for SMFNC, \$10k Short term loan to SMFNC (has been repaid), \$4.5 for Blue Shed
- 2019 Northport we will contribute financially to the development of this ground
- We will investigate investment toward an electronic Scoreboard to the value of around \$20,000.

Election of Office Bearers

Firstly, thank you to all of our Committee for the excellent work they have done over the season. I hear what happens within other Clubs and some of the internal politics and our Club is very lucky to have such good people who demonstrate such great ethics toward the running of the Club.

Special thanks to Tinet for her fantastic work as Auskick Coordinator in her second year. Auskick 2.0 introduced and Corey Wilson has done a great job with it. Tinet has been very organised and embraced the role and our Auskick program has run really well this season.

Chrissy and Mandy taking on the Registrar role and reviewing and redeveloping the Managers Packs etc. Will make the position a lot easier for incoming Registrars.

Kevan – Thanked for his work as VP. Setting up Team App for all teams and for involvement in other more confidential matters.

Mel – for taking over Merchandise with an income of \$4.5k, and to Sharyn taking over Kidsport Voucher coordination which amounts to \$17,000 for 108 kids.

Before we seek nominations for positions, it was mentioned that given the need to work online, and communicate via email, any prospective Committee Members will find their role much easier if they have access to email and be an average level user of a PC/Laptop. The Club has a lot of emails and lists bouncing around, especially at the start of the season, so having appropriate computer skills really helps.

Notes from general meeting with Coaches and Managers

• Game day Behaviour

Lots of yellows this year and e-points (across all teams). Not looking good for a club award. Please educate the players about onfield niggle etc. You can speak to umps before game. Discussion was had, and Jade Boaler bought up that the umpire decisions were not consistent. Others thought that umpires were issuing yellow cards for rough play rather than for valid reasons. Especially in the younger years umpires were not experienced enough. What are the team officials thoughts? Stricter or not? Good or bad? Discussion ensued.

- Coach AFL Platform. 6 points to automatically reaccredit. (5 points to be on coach.afl, and completing a coaching module will give an extra 2 points). 4 points for the face to face at our club. Modules to be added soon.
- Playing in one team. Not permitted to play in any other team. We have been fined.
- 50% game time in finals Forfeit if not abided by.
- Even-up, not down. If teams don't even-up let Nick know.
- Wind-ups. They clash with hols but are on at the traditional time. Please attend the club wind-ups but also feel free to organise your own if you want.
- Match day complaints. In an email to Nick please, not verbally.
- Coaches area. Coaches responsible for runners, water carriers, managers and assistant coaches. Anything goes wrong it is the Coaches responsibility.
- Finals meeting week of finals
- Return of Team Gear

This year we would like all playing gear and Managers Packs, left over umpire money, to be returned as one package per team.

It may be an opportune time to let players know to bring a top to put on after their game and return their jumper.

Please do not return bags with missing jumpers etc. All jumpers need to be returned and washed and packed in kit bags and marked off on the jumper inventory before they are returned .
