3.0 President's Report

Another very successful year with Registrations. Covid meant a slow start but registrations flowed in as the season commence. Slightly down on Auskick numbers but all Clubs were.

- 3.1 Equipment

Purchased from new supplier Slater Gartrell and was easy to deal with. We did stock up on discounted gear when Sports power closed down.

 No new jumpers this year due to short season and long lead times. New jumpers required next year.

3.2 Good sports Level 3

Level 3 Good sports maintained this year. Good Sports accreditation is about creating a safe and family-friendly environment and being mindful of alcohol and smoking at junior sport. We want to be THE club of choice in the Peel, and continue to work towards providing the best game day environment for the kids.

3.3 Ocean Rd and Northport Oval

- Northport development completed for junior games. \$120k development funded by City. We built the dugouts for \$12.7K

3.4 Season 2021

- Next season we will again look at a no pay-no play policy from round 1 to avoid the extra work in chasing money. It worked well the last two seasons.
- Will look to renew existing sponsors next season and add new sponsors. Hoping for 10 major sponsors to cover 2021/22.

3.5 Coaches and Managers

- Next year's Coaches and Managers For returning coaches and managers there is an incentive of \$50 fee discount for each of your kids you coach or manage, plus the normal free polo for first time coaches and managers, free photo, free coach accreditation, free wind-up.
- If you have already agreed to volunteer as a Manager or Coach next season, the Club thanks you once again for your invaluable support and for supporting our community youth. If you are unable to do so, then thank you for your past support and hopefully your continued support as a general member. If you aren't continuing, we would also like to ask you to please try and arrange a replacement within your team. It makes it a lot easier at the start of the season.

4.0 Treasurers Report and Financial Statements

- 4.1 Budget Position is very sound. We finished the financial year with \$115k in the bank. However there is a lot of spending to be done after the EOFY on 30 June. We need to pay levies, fees, photos, wind-ups and trophies.
- 4.2 At the time of this meeting (October 2020) we currently have \$81k in the bank with an estimated spend of \$20k still to occur on trophies and windups. This will leave us with \$60k in the bank.
- 4.3 Major expenditure \$15k Loan to Senior Club for payment of coaches. In 2018. This is being paid back at \$100 per week over 3 years. We have received payment of \$3200 so far. Payments were suspended due to covid.
- 4.4 Ex-gratia payment of \$7k to Senior Club in 2020 to pay their coaches
- 4.5 Northport Oval build \$13k
- 4.6 We had \$2k in the bank when I became Club Pres 5 years ago so we are now in a very sound position.
