
SOUTH MANDURAH JUNIOR FOOTBALL CLUB

BY-LAWS



2. OBJECTS: (ii, iii & iv)

To act, at all times, in the interests of the Members and to promote Australian Rules Football as a sport within the communities in which the Club operates.

To foster the development of young people in the community by providing a safe environment to pursue athletic endeavor.

To affiliate and otherwise liaise with the Peel District Junior Football Association, of which the Club is a member, and adopt their rules and policy frameworks to further the objectives of the club. In reference to the constitution clauses 2.0 Objects (ii, iii & iv)

At completion of each season, final year Auskick players the coaches shall grade players using the Grade Number Table as a guide.

At the start of the next season, Year 3 players shall be place into teams with equal spread of grading numbers.

At completion of each season, Year 6 the coaches shall grade players using the Grade Number Table as a guide.

At the start of the next season, Year 7 players shall be placed into teams with equal spread of grading numbers.

At completion of each season, Year 8 the coaches shall grade players using the Grade Number Table as a guide.

At the start of the next season, Year 9 players shall be placed into teams with equal spread of grading numbers.

At completion of each season, Year 10 the coaches shall grade players using the Grade Number Table as a guide.

At the start of the next season, Year 11/12 (Under 18s) players shall be placed into teams with equal spread of grading numbers.

Youth Registrar and President may review player grading for Year 8 or Year 10 if teams become uneven because of player movements in and out of the club.

The Junior Registrar, Youth Registrar and President shall allocate team members in consultation with the Coach's Manager and current year coaches.

This only applies if the club has more than 1 team in the same age group within the Youth Division Age Groups.

Use the **Grading Number Table** for determining player grading number for equalising teams' check. **Grading Number Table**

Grade Number	Description
1	Above Average Skilled Player
2	Average Skilled Player
3	Below Average Skilled Player

Use the **Team Equalisation Check Schedule Table** to decide when to do age group equalisation check
