PARENTS / MEMBERS CODE OF CONDUCT



This Code of Conduct applies to all our Parents of Registered Junior/Youth/Auskick Players.

- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every person and not engage in inappropriate behaviour towards any person based on race, religion, gender, ability, cultural background.
- Demonstrate appropriate social behaviour by not using foul or abusive language, racial vilification or physical intimidation towards other members, umpires, opposition players and coaches, game officials or other spectators.
- Not to engage in conduct which would be likely to bring the SMJFC into disrepute
- Respect the right of all spectators to enjoy the game in an enjoyable and safe environment
- Respect the coach and player's space whilst on the oval on match days and allow them room to warm up, enter and leave the oval. This includes game breaks
- Not use social media or any other platform online or otherwise to bully, racially vilify, defame, belittle, make derogatory comments about any persons from the South Mandurah Junior Football Club or any other club or otherwise make statements that bring the South Mandurah Junior Football Club into disrepute.

By registering with South Mandurah Junior Football Club, I agree to abide by these principles.

I support the Club in its undertakings and encourage the Club to take any necessary disciplinary action including the suspension and banning where warranted of any parents for repeated or serious breaches of the Parents Code of Conduct.

I also support the club in any disciplinary actions related to players including the suspension or banning of players, for either repeated or serious breaches of the players' code of conduct.

Note: Invited guests are the responsibility of the parent, and these principles apply to all invited guests.
