



## ***SAJC Executive Committee Meeting Minutes***

***Monday, March 23, 2026, 10:00 am***

**Meeting Place: La Madeline, 410 & Blanco**

This Meeting agenda was developed and sent out by Gabriel before the meeting, and included these items and discussion:

1. • Concours update, including trophies. The event and sanction request was input into jcna.com by Brian on Saturday, 3/21. No response was expected this quickly, but all preparations for the input were reviewed. Brian noted that Austin still showed sanctioning as blank on the JCNA calendar, and theirs was input some weeks ago. Trophies have been ordered and received, and the reimbursement has been received by Brian from Bob.
2. • 2026 Budget review. SAJC Treasurer Bob Sheldon led a brief review of budget items, including Luckenbach, Concours, and All British Car Day. Brian indicated that we will probably not be needing the \$100 for printing in the Luckenbach budget, and the IT budget looks right on. The budget was agreed to, and Bob was thanked for developing it.
- 3. Luckenbach rally update. Brian advised that the route has been finalized and route instructions will be developed by Easter. Start point will be Old Blanco County Courthouse Square in Blanco on April 25. Registration begins at 11AM and first car leaves at 12:31PM. Route will be less than 100 miles and will arrive in Luckenbach before 3:30PM. Luckenbach has given approval by email for us to park on the grass upon arrival. Trophies have not been ordered as of yet, but will be ordered soon. John Sullivan has volunteered to work a checkpoint, and the first invite I sent out requested volunteers for two more checkpoints. No volunteers as of yet. Invites was also sent out to British car clubs, and some members of Corvette club.
- 4. Donation to Polly Mansion. Gabriel spoke about the Wilson County tour organized by Clay Maeckel and how much everyone enjoyed it. He proposed and there was agreement to donate \$100 on behalf of the club to Polly Mansion that was included on the tour.
5. Upcoming Spring Fling. The President of JC of Austin, Lynn Wills, has requested a regional leadership meeting in advance of the upcoming Annual General Meeting in Mexico City on April 17. Their club is the host of the annual All Texas Jaguar Club social event this year, in Fredericksburg. All club presidents, regional directors, and their invitees will discuss the agenda:
  - JCNA leadership slate for the upcoming year – we discussed most of our officers' preferences would be for Mark Mayuga to not return as JCNA President
  - Judging criteria and the rule book – we discussed how we should vote on the proposed Series I Judging Guide if it comes up for a vote. Steve Collins shared his discussions with Mike Mueller of JC of Austin about it. Brian recommended to Gabriel that with the information we currently have, that he 'be like Mike (Mueller)' and use our club votes to say it needs more work and reject it.

- Concours replacement trophies - we have enough for 2026, and we will see if we have to go a different direction in 2027 due to the end of the JCNA Club trophy program.
- JCNA transparency – Lack of published board meeting minutes, a 2026 JCNA budget, and other items is a concern JCOA wants to get a joint position to JCNA from all the Texas clubs.
- Club growth issues - Our membership is up somewhat, but what this discussion would entail was not well understood by us at this meeting.
- Future dues increase – Not sure what was to be discussed in Fredericksburg about this subject, but the JCNA trend has been to consume some deposited funds each year, at a rate that would burn through them in another 5 years. Improvements in cost reduction occurred in 2024, but we do not know how 2025 turned out yet.

6. All British Car Day - Brian reported that Robert Clemons has reported progress on getting Boerne Main Plaza for October 24<sup>th</sup> permitted by Boerne Parks. We expect to see an invoice for around \$650, most of which is deposit, any day now.
