



SAJC Officers and Directors Meeting Minutes

Thursday, May 21, 2026, 10:00 am

Meeting Place: La Madeline, 410 & Blanco

This Meeting agenda was developed and sent out by Gabriel before the meeting, and included the below items and discussion. The meeting objective was stated to review upcoming and future club events, confirm priorities, and assign the officers or members responsible for each event's success.

1. Upcoming Events

- a. Joint drive event with the Austin club. – Saturday, May 30, there will be a joint lunch, meet, and Hill Country Drive with the Jaguar Club of Austin. It will begin in Blanco at 11:00AM with a meetup for lunch at The Bistro at Blanco River (Soon to be Rustica), followed by a drive to the Willow City Loop, ending at the Foyt Winery and Museum on US290. Brian to finish defining route and put out by the weekend. Gabriel indicated 8 cars and 14 people had RSVP'd from SAJC.
- b. Winery/distillery drive in June (date TBD). Driver: Janet Martin. – Date for this is June 27th, and Gabriel will be in touch with Janet about destinations and starting point and time.
- c. Drive and lunch at The Purple Pig on July 11. Driver: D. Herron. – It was agreed that we need to contact Demetric and define when and further details.
- d. Technical event on July 25 at S. Collins's garage condo. – A welding and spot weld removal demonstration will be on the agenda. Steve will provide pizza and asks everyone to BYOB and RSVP.

2. Future Events

- a. Concours on September 25–26. - With sanction approved, the only part of our probation effort to do would be to send Dave Allen a copy of the event invitation when we publish it in late July. Brian will create the invitation and send it, once the event details, including hotel and banquet are available to include. Gabriel has already visited the Jaguar dealer and will have to make a return visit to see his contact who was not there. Manny will look into the banquet with the idea to price the same place as last year again.
- b. All British Car Day on October 24. – Robert Clemons has been working with Boerne Parks and the event permit appears imminent. What police coverage is required or costing is not known yet. They have requested a second round of clarifications on the event Certificate of Insurance that we obtain through a JCNA covered service. The revised certificate was

forwarded to Boerne on the morning of this meeting, and has since been accepted. Brian will call a meeting with the four sponsor clubs in late June, and begin working on defining the event T shirt costs and making an event registration form and flyer. Will not publish this until after the first meeting and we can establish a budget and determine if pricing needs to be increased.

3. Other Items

- a. Fall Smithsonian Touring Exhibit in Taylor, Tx this fall - Jeff Snyder with Jeff's Resurrections in Taylor is heavily involved with facilitating a traveling exhibit on rural America by The Smithsonian from August 16 through September 29. Taylor, Texas was selected for the state of Texas, and the exhibit will be adjacent to Jeff's Resurrections. Steve Collins is going to contact Jeff Snyder and possibly the Austin club about coordinating a date when we could all go see this exhibit, and drive a stretch of TX 130 with its 85 MPH speed limit.
