MDE entry will be used to

Please Note: 1) The above features work with a MDE account. To assure accurate information and the best trial experience, please be sure your entry is in MDE 2) If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly until closing.

Paper Entry Information. Limit is 20 runs. MDE paper entries are given priority.

Email confirmations will be sent to those providing a legible email address on their entry form. If you would like to receive your entry status by USPS prior to the issuance of the preliminary judging schedule at closing, please enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope or postcard along with your entry.

- Only one dog per entry form, include AKC titles only.
- All entries must be original copies submitted on official AKC Agility Entry Forms and must include an attached signed AKC agreement. Unsigned, incomplete, or illegible entries are **NOT** acceptable and will not be entered into the trial (Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 4).
- Faxed entries and/or credit cards cannot be accepted with paper entry.
- Entries received within 24 hours of the opening date and time must: 1) include postage or be metered; and 2) be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier services, including, but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS, and DHL. Please waive signature requirements on all forms of delivery. **Mail requiring signatures will be returned to the sender.**
- A maximum of ten (10) entries per envelope are allowed. Envelopes with more than ten (10) entries and/or entries received prior to the opening date will be returned.
- No mailed entry not in MDE may be changed or cancelled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing by the Trial Secretary prior to the closing date and hour for entries.
- Make checks out to **Platte Valley Kennel Club (PVKC)**.
- A returned check charge of \$35 will be leveled.
- Move ups (prior to trials) will be accepted until **Sept. 21st, 2026** at 5 pm CT.
- Day to day move ups will be accepted and must be provided to the Trial Secretary in writing at the trial site not later than the day preceding the event.

Wait List for Withdrawn Entries After Closing Date/Time

A wait list will be kept until Monday, September 21st, 2025 to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 30 entries for each day will be placed on the wait list. Any entries received by the closing date/time that are withdrawn before the wait list deadline will be replaced by a wait listed entry, if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait list entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. If an entry is cancelled, but cannot be replaced, the exhibitor will not receive a refund and the dog will be considered absent for the trials. Any wait list entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by the wait list close date will receive a full refund. You must use MDE.

Ribbons and Awards

Ribbons will be awarded in each jump height division in each class as follows:

First Place – Blue	Second Place – Red
Third Place – Yellow	Fourth Place – White
Qualifying Score – Dark Green	

A new title ribbon will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title.

MACH or PACH rosette and decorated MACH or PACH bar will be awarded to all dog and handler teams that achieve their MACH or PACH. Double and Triple Q rosettes will be awarded. Brag Tags plus HIT: FAST & T2B Friday, Open STD/JWW Saturday, Novice STD/JWW Sunday. Run times used for tie breakers. ISC classes will have 1st – 3rd prizes.

Daily Quint Q Coup Tournament & Prizes

Any dog entering **all five eligible** classes on any trial day will be automatically entered into the tournament for the day.

Any level combination for the five classes is acceptable. For example: STD Novice, JWW Excellent, FAST Open, T2B and ISC J2 would be considered a valid entry for Friday The Premier class has a single class level. Dogs Eligible to enter Novice, Open, Excellent or Master level classes may enter the Premier Class.

Prizes will be awarded for **quintuple Q's** earned by **EVERY** dog for the day. These will be \$25 vouchers for future entry to Platte Valley Kennel Club Trials and must be redeemed through mydogentry.com. Additional Voucher Prizes awarded **DAILY** as follows:

1. Fastest dog will receive..... \$100
2. Second fastest will receive..... \$50
3. Third fastest will receive..... \$25

In the event there are no quintuple Q's earned, quadruple Q's then triple Q's will be used.

Note: ISC scoring is faults, then time – this will be converted to Q for the tournament. If quadruple or triple Q's are used this ranking will break ties: NQ, FEO, E, ABS.

Junior Ribbons and Awards

In addition to any regular placements, Juniors will be awarded 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th places for each class for qualifying runs.

From the East: I-80 Exit #442 - I-80 at Giles Road/ Harrison St. Turn Right onto Giles Road. Proceed to Harrison Street (traffic light). Turn Right onto Harrison Street. Proceed to 110th Street. Turn Right onto 110th Street (traffic light). Off the Wall Soccer is on the right, past the gas station & car wash. Overflow parking on the left at the ESU across the street.

From the West: I-80 Exit #442 - I-80 at Giles Road/ Harrison St. Turn Left onto Giles Road. Proceed to Harrison Street (traffic light). Turn Right onto Harrison Street (traffic light). Proceed to 110th Street. Turn Right onto 110th Street (traffic light). . Off the Wall Soccer is on the right, past the gas station & car wash. Overflow parking on the left at the ESU across the street.

Links to maps are on MDE for the trial.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

All dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Privileges (PAL/ILP), and AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Services (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Bitches in season, aggressive dogs, blind dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate.

Obstacles and Ring Conditions

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. Club may use Saloon style tire for the ISC classes as allowed for 2026.

All classes will take place indoors, air-conditioned facility on soccer turf. Ring size will be 85' x 110'. Soccer turf was replaced Fall 2023.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS FOR INTERNATIONAL SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES (ISC):

Purpose: The international sweepstakes class (ISC) is a non-regular class providing the dog and handler an opportunity to demonstrate their advanced training and handling skills on various international style Standard and Jumpers With Weaves courses. The rules for this class are generally based on international rules. The variety in international agility course designs is very diverse, so handlers should be prepared to meet the "Challenge of the Day" when competing in the ISC class. The total challenge level may be easier, more difficult, or simply different from what is currently allowed in excellent / master Class. Complete rules for the ISC are available from the AKC website (<http://www.akc.org>).

Eligibility: This class is open to dogs that are eligible to compete in AKC agility trials.

Jump heights: Dogs may be entered in their regular jump heights, however, only those dogs running in the 12" & 16" class that meet the FCI/ISC measuring cutoff (different than regular AKC Cutoffs) or any dog entering the 24" jump height will be eligible for the direct invitation to World Team Tryouts. The FCI/ISC cutoffs for those heights are as follows:

- 12" - Small team – shoulder height = 13 3/4" or less (35 cm is the FCI cutoff)
- 16" - Medium team – shoulder height = 16 7/8" or less (43 cm is the FCI cutoff)
- 20" - Intermediate team – shoulder height = 18 7/8" or less (48 cm is the FCI cutoff)
- 24" - Large team – shoulder height = greater than 18 7/8" (greater than 48 cm)

Course Walk-Throughs and Warm-up Information

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. Only handlers entered in the class will be permitted on the course. Walkthroughs may be limited to 25 handlers. If multiple walkthroughs are required for a class, they will be back-to-back and there will be no 5 minute countdown clock.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, shall be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training the dog.

Notice to Exhibitors

Food: Limited concessions & refreshments are available on site. Fast food restaurants are within 1 mile of site. More information on the Confirmation Letter. **Trial Site** will be available after 7:00 AM Friday, Saturday and Sunday. This trial will be held indoors on soccer turf. Bring chairs, crates, and clean-up tools. Dogs must be removed from the trial site each day upon completion of the trial.

Indoor crating space is available but separated from the agility ring. No ex-pens will be permitted inside the building.

Water proof crate mats or tarps are required under crates.

Rules Changes: For Exhibition Only (FEO) allowed in all classes. A mixture of classes & jump heights is allowed at this trial per AKC change notice for rules effective July 1, 2024. Fix and Go (FNG) is allowed. See AKC rules for details. FEO and FNG result in a non-qualifying score (NQ).

NO FOOD OR BEVERAGES (EXCEPT WATER) WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE SOCCER FLOOR SURFACE.

Refunds

- **Bitches in season will not be allowed to compete. Deceased dog's entry will be refunded.** Entry fees less \$6.00 per run administrative fee and applicable AKC Recording fees per day (\$4.50 per run entered) will be refunded for bitches coming in season after the closing date. Owner must present certificate from veterinarian prior to start of show.
- **No refunds** will be given in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.
- If, because of riots or civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the trial, no refund of entry will be made.
- Platte Valley Kennel Club reserves the right to cancel these trials in the event of extreme weather conditions and no entry fee refunds will be made in such case.

Ringside

- **Dogs may arrive** any time prior to judging if the dog has a valid temporary or permanent jump height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their classes if a VMO or AKC Field Rep is available to measure dogs. The exhibitor's instructions will state if a VMO will be at this trial. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.
- **Measurements:** When filling out the entry form, there is a check box on the form for exhibitors to designate if their dog needs to be measured. If your dog does need to be measured, please check the box so that the Trial Secretary knows to include your dog on the Dogs To Be Measured List. If a VMO or AKC Field Rep is present and measuring, dogs must be measured if they
 - Are under 2 years old and do NOT have a temporary height card
 - Are over 2 years old and do not have at least one official measurement.
 - You are responsible for ensuring your dog is entered in the appropriate height, if no measuring occurs during the trial.
- **Judges are not required to wait for dogs.** Exhibitors alone are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.
- **Mydogentry will be used for check-in & monitoring the run order.** Every effort will be made to space dogs run by the same handler in the same class. Entering through mydogentry will assure the best check-in and run order experience.
- **Course Maps will be distributed in Mydogentry. One set will be posted.**

Safety, Behavior and Liability

- **By entering this trial**, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- The Platte Valley Kennel Club and AKC assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, injury, or death sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and assumes no responsibility for injury to children not under control of their parent(s) or guardian(s).
- Any exhibitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. There will be no refunds of entry fees if a person is asked to leave the trial site.
- **All dogs** must be on leash at all times when not in the ring or in the designated warm-up area. La Vista requires all dogs to be on a leash or confined outdoors.
- **Exhibitors** are expected to comply with the La Vista's Disposal of Dog Waste Ordinance: *Any person having custody or control of any dog shall have the responsibility of disposing of dog feces or manure of the dog in a sanitary manner.*
- **Crates** may be left overnight; however, the Platte Valley Kennel Club and Off the Wall Soccer will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.
- Currently, masks are optional. At the time of the trial, if local regulations require it, masks could be required at all times on site except while running. There is plenty of space for social distancing.
- By entering this trial you are releasing PVKC and the trial facility from any impact or consequences of communicable disease. Be kind, respectful, and do your part to ensure safety of yourself, your dogs and other trial attendees.
- **Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation** to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. The City of La Vista requires a Rabies Vaccinations.
- **All dogs on site MUST belong to an entered competitor.**
- **No Puppies under four months of age are allowed on the trial site.**

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners SM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
