On behalf of the Dika-Moka Youth Development Forum and concerned citizens across the Global South, we submit this urgent briefing as a moral and existential intervention to end systemic violence threatening humanity and life on Earth.

How Nuclear Weapons Could End Civilization

Nuclear weapons pose catastrophic threats through:

• Immediate Destruction & Radioactive Fallout:

- A single thermonuclear warhead (e.g., B83, $80 \times$ Hiroshima) can kill over 500,000 instantly.

- A U.S.Russia war (1,000+ warheads) could kill 300 million instantly, with 5+ billion starving, ending civilization.

Key Concerns:

- Modernization hypocrisy: NPT members pledge disarmament but invest in upgrades.
- Double standards: Allies like Israel face no sanctions, while Iran is targeted.
- Deterrence paradox: Nuclear powers prevent others acquisition, enforcing a violent hierarchy.

- African communities suffer cancer, birth defects, and water poisoning from mining waste.

• Hypocrisy of Western Defense Trade:
