ABOUT US

Malabo is the first artisanal upcycling laboratory, fully vertical and with zero impact.

We are Tiziana Lamonaca - production manager, and Federico Nistri - sales manager, with twenty years of experience in the vintage clothing sector.

We created Malabo, a brand born from a passion for vintage and a love for the environment. We decided to reinvent ourselves to respond to the growing focus on green and environmental concerns.

The production side of Malabo is carried out in partnership with the team of Noell Maggini, an Italian stylist and designer, a prominent figure in the Italian Haute Couture sector.

We have built the first fully vertical, zeroimpact artisanal upcycling laboratory.

We produce patchwork fabrics for home decor and fashion collections, using entirely unsellable used clothes and discontinued fabric stocks.

ZERO IMPACT

At Malabo, we are dedicated to creating reworked products, not just recycled ones.

Recycling is a noble art that favors and cares for the environment; however, it is not without environmental consequences and therefore cannot be defined as "zero impact."

While recycling transforms used materials into new raw materials, reworking (or upcycling) directly reinvents existing garments and fabrics.

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A recycled yarn or any recycled fabric requires countless steps to become reusable: mechanical and chemical processes that consume energy and produce other highly polluting substances. And dozens of liters of water are needed to recycle just one kilogram.

At Malabo, we do not recycle; we reinvent, deconstruct, and modify the natural state of products through exclusively artisanal processes within our laboratories. In this way, we manage to give new life to wornout raw materials without impacting the ecosystem.

We follow the philosophy of upcycling (or reworking), which, in synergy with the most creative minds in fashion and home design, brings forth a new concept of sustainable production: Eco-Design.

OUR BACKGROUND

Born and raised in Prato, we have embraced its unique art of textile recycling, for which the city has been famous since the post-war period.

Prato is considered the largest textile center in Europe and one of the most important hubs in the world for the production of wool yarns and fabrics.

In Prato, there are about 2,000 textile companies producing fabrics for the clothing industry, for home furnishings, and yarns for knitwear production, as well as special fabrics for purely industrial uses.



The textile district of Prato has always been able to combine creativity with technological innovation, thus creating technical textiles, a particular production of yarn suitable for industrial use. Prato has therefore surpassed the concept of traditional fiber uses and has developed technologically in a significant way.

In this context, given the growing attention to green and eco-sustainability in recent years, we at Malabo decided to reinvent ourselves: we started producing reworked clothing, and Pet and Home Design lines, taking the Prato textile industry one step further.

Today, in a world that loudly calls for sustainability and Italian craftsmanship, Malabo aims to make its contribution.

HOW WE WORK

Our processes are handmade, but we produce on a large scale, collaborating with some of the most important and influential figures in contemporary fashion.

Thanks to our distribution headquarters, Magis s.r.l., and our network of suppliers who embrace the upcycling philosophy, we have access to direct and substantial quantities of raw materials.

This is precisely why we can keep our research and development department constantly active, where we experiment with increasingly efficient material recovery methods.




SUPPLY CHAIN

At the heart of every Malabo creation is an ethical and transparent supply chain that values sustainability and craftsmanship. From the careful recovery of used materials to their transformation into unique and innovative garments, every step of our production process is designed to minimize environmental impact and promote responsible labor practices.

- 1. Malabo relies on major European storage sites to source used clothing from urban collections that would otherwise be disposed of (most textile waste (73%) is typically directed to landfills or incineration, causing severe damage to natural ecosystems).
- 2. At the storage sites, the selection process and initial quality control of the materials intended for Malabo's design and tailoring processes take place. Malabo buys and uses only what is needed: this helps us minimize waste and production scraps.

- 3. The selected materials are then collected by Malabo, which performs a second inspection and further quality control. This process ensures that only the finest fabrics are used, guaranteeing the creation of garments and products that are not only unique but also of high quality and durability.
- 4. Based on the selected materials and their characteristics, Malabo determines the destination of each individual garment. At Malabo, we start with the raw material and assess how to best enhance it in the product, not the other way around! This approach allows us to use all available materials and focus on the uniqueness of the pieces we produce.
- 5. The material is then processed in the workshop, where the design phase occurs and the products come to life. Given the distinctive nature of Malabo's ideation-production process, the design phase is crucial. It involves the study of each product and the Upcycling Design techniques that will be used.
