Ref: Recent terror attack by a trained medical doctor acting as suicide bomber in New Delhi

Dear Sir/Madam,

New Delhi, the capital of India, is one of the most populated metropolitan regions on Earth, home to more than twenty million people. With its intense economic and industrial activity, it also has a large floating population consisting of travelers from other parts of the country.

During the evening rush hour on 10 November, in the densely populated inner city, a bomb detonated inside a stationary Hyundai i20 car at a traffic signal. The devastating explosion claimed the lives of 13 innocent civilians, injured many others, and caused significant damage to nearby vehicles and shops.

Initial investigations revealed that the blast was a terror attack carried out by a suicide bomber, Dr Umar Un Nabi, who was driving the car. Just a few days earlier, investigators discovered a cache of arms and nearly 3000 kg of explosives at Al Falah University campus on the outskirts of the Delhi metropolitan area.

Nearly a week later, investigators revealed the names of four conspirators, sending shock waves across the country. All four were medical doctors, followers of the Islamic faith, who were teaching and practicing medicine at the university. Among them was a woman doctor who had been instructed by her handlers abroad to radicalize young women and recruit them into the female faction of a terror-linked organization, Jamat-e-Islami. As the investigation expanded, authorities uncovered more Doctors involved in producing ricin—an extremely toxic substance—to use as a bioweapon targeting the food chain.

To date, investigators have arrested more than 20 medical doctors, paramedics and an Islamic cleric linked to the so-called “Doctor Module.” This group had planned to purchase 32 cars to use as an Improvised Explosive device for a series of coordinated terror attacks. In a recently surfaced video, Dr. Umar Nabi—the suicide bomber who drove the car on 10 November—claimed that suicide bombing is often misunderstood and is, in fact, a path to martyrdom preordained by Allah. Had the “Doctor Module” succeeded in carrying out their plans, the human toll could have reached thousands.

We still do not fully understand the motives, financial backers, and full network of conspirators behind this terror plot, as the investigation is ongoing and new details continue to emerge.

This incident has shattered several commonly held beliefs, such as the idea that terrorism stems from a lack of economic or social opportunity or that terrorism has no connection to religion. These individuals were highly qualified MDs, earning respectable salaries, and enjoying high social status within a medical university. In his recorded message, Dr. Umar Nabi clearly states how religious teachings motivated him to pursue what he viewed as the path of martyrdom. This provides clear evidence that religious teaching was his sole motivator for the suicide bombing. We are often led to believe that terrorism takes root in societies deprived of social and economic opportunities.

This developing story carries important lessons for democratic societies such as Europe and India. However, it has received only fleeting attention in the European media, likely because a massive serial terror attack was prevented through timely raids and the recovery of explosives.

On Wednesday (November 12, 2025) (local time), U.S. Secretary of State Marco Rubio described the blast in Delhi as “clearly” a “terrorist attack.” He praised the country’s professionalism in handling the investigation. However, no widespread condemnation came from the Dutch government or political parties.

With this letter, Sunrise Foundation appeals to the Dutch political parties to condemn the terror attack and take strong measures to prevent Islamic radicalization in the world and in The Netherlands, which remains the root cause of a large number terrorism-related deaths and destruction.







NEW DELHI, Nov 20 (Reuters) - India's anti-terrorism agency said on Thursday it had arrested four more people, including three doctors, in connection with last week's [deadly car blast](#) in Delhi, the first such attack in the heavily-guarded capital in more than a decade.

The [car bomb](#) killed 10 people and wounded 32 outside the historic Red Fort on November 10.
