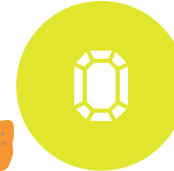
Medicine

Sanatan Dharma (aka Hinduism) founded in 3200 BC Spiritual Lifestyle (aka Yoga) originated in 5000BC



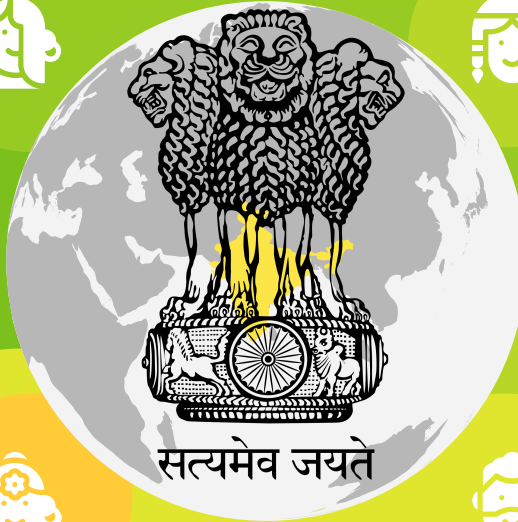

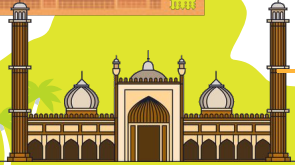
Golden Temple, Amritsar

INDIAN diaspora in USA

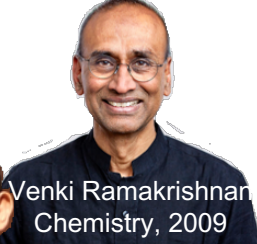
- 3.8 million (1.2% of population)

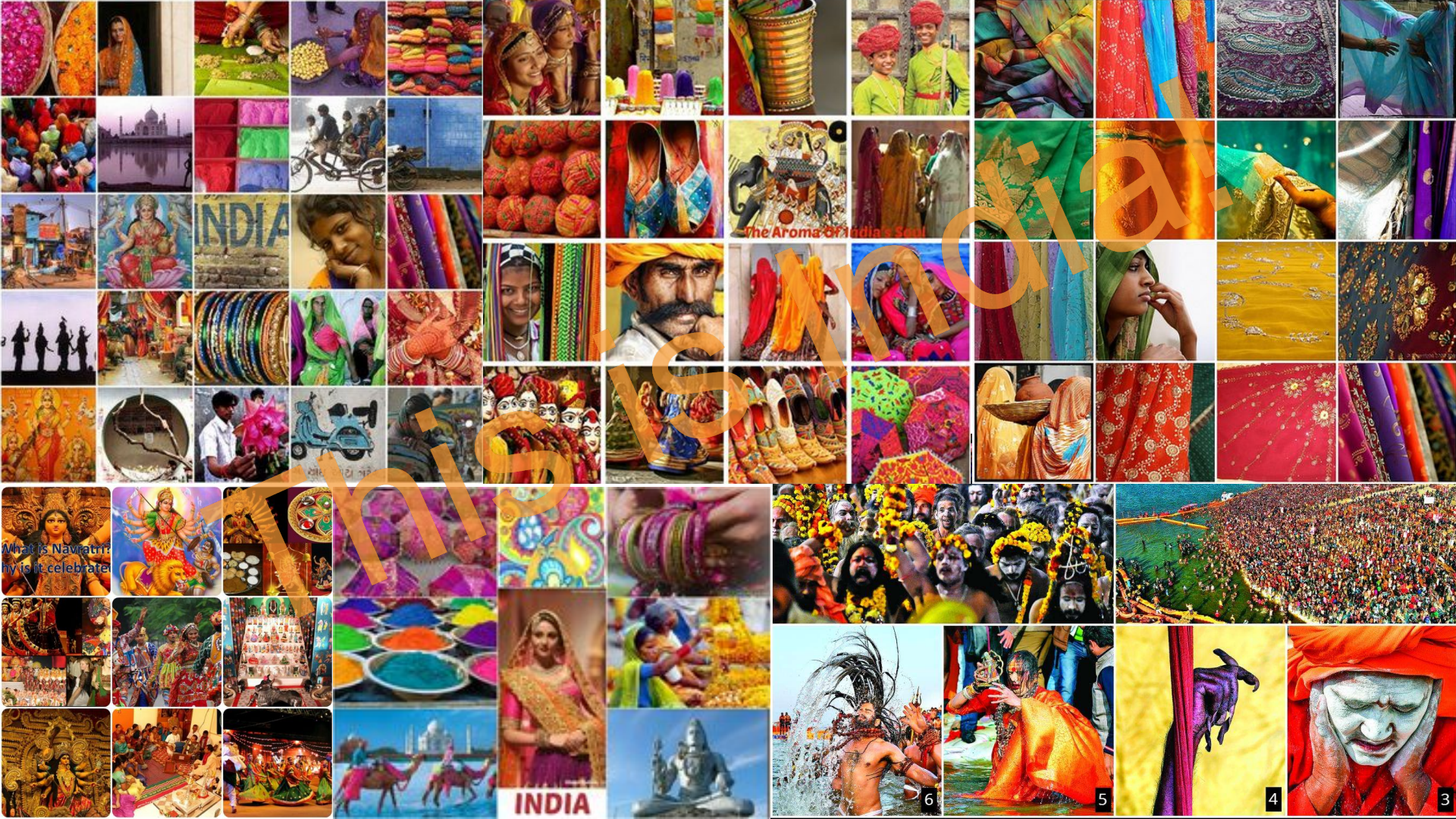

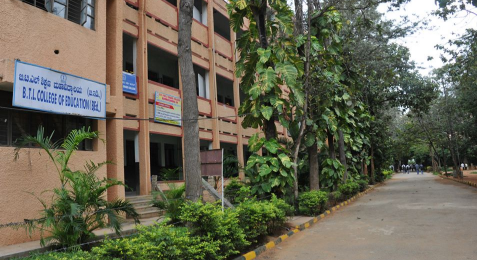

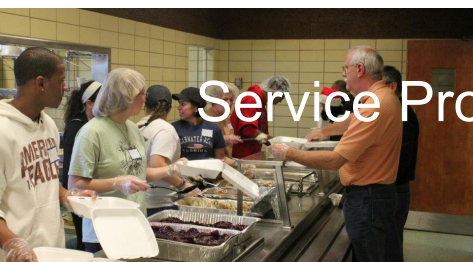
