*A very short play, in one Act*

-F = "fascist"

-Ph = "philosopher"

Act 1:

F: "Do you support Hamas?"

Ph: "Do you mean the largest group in Palestine that's fighting back against the genocide of their entire population? Instead of just, you know, politely disintegrating?"

F: "Well, sure, if you say it that WEIRD way, but... Wait! I asked you a question. No dodging, you slippery thinky-about-things person! DO YOU SUPPORT HAMAS?!!"

Ph: "Well, only insofar as I'm not a coward, I suppose."

F: "Come again?"

Ph: "Cowards *love* Israel, you know. *Man*, do they love it!"

F: "Wait, what? Why on earth would...?"

Ph: "Because most Israelis (unlike the rest of the Jewish people, throughout history) are cowards, too--JUST like most Americans. Have you ever noticed how both settler colonies prefer to fight? Video game-operated drones. Missiles. Planes so high, kindergarteners look like cockroaches. *'It's, like, cool tech, bruh'.*"

F: "Um..."

Ph: "But when Israeli 'soldiers' set one foot on Palestinian land, they tend to poop themselves. Before they can even shoot--often themselves. Mostly by accident, but, sometimes on purpose. That whole 'Hannibal Lector' thing, or whatever."

F: "No, it's 'Hannibal DIRECTIVE.' It sounds VERY cool, it's like 'Golden Lion of the Rising Split Eagle.' They have ALL the best code names!"

Ph: "Anyway... Brave people love the Palestinians. Because most Palestinians are brave. Maybe the bravest people on earth right now, actually. It's like David and Goliath, except the two Semites' roles are reversed. So that it fits logically with, you know...reality."
