CURATORIAL

ID • Dunia yang dipenuhi warna warni kehidupan dan terus bergerak tanpa henti. Salah satu yang melekat di kehidupan manusia adalah “**Duka**”. Dalam konteks “**The Colors Of Grief**” pada pameran tunggal Mira merupakan wujud perjalanan titik dimensional duka yang mengakibatkan luka batin, kehilangan dan trauma. Melalui karya-karyanya merupakan proses perjalanan hidup dalam menemukan dan memulihkan duka. Mengundang anda untuk melangkah ke ruang kontemplatif tempat emosi bertemu dengan seni. Pameran ini menggali secara mendalam pengalaman kesedihan manusia secara universal, mengeksplorasinya melalui beragam seni visual kontemporer.

Kanvas yang dilukis Mira dengan kenangan, kehilangan, dan rasa sakit karena ketidakhadiran. Karya Mira, berupaya menyampaikan berbagai aspek kesedihan, yang masing-masing merupakan meditasi pribadi Mira sebagai seorang seniman terhadap subjek tersebut. “**The Colors Of Grief**” bukanlah pengalaman monocrom, Ini adalah spektrum emosi, masing-masing warna menceritakan kisah kehilangan, cinta, dan penyembuhannya sendiri. Di sini, Anda akan menemukan beragam interpretasi artistik, mulai dari yang muram dan introspektif hingga yang bergairah.

Melalui berbagai medium, Mira menggunakan warna, tekstur, bentuk, dan simbolisme untuk membangkitkan kedalam dan keragaman proses berduka. Kami mengundang Anda untuk dapat berhenti sejenak, merenung, dan mungkin menemukan warna kesedihan Anda sendiri. Saat Anda menjelajahi pameran ini dapat terlibat menjadi katalisator dialog dan intropksi, memberikan ruang bagi pengunjung untuk terhubung dengan emosi sendiri dan orang lain. Dalam perjumpaan bersama dengan karya Mira, kita diingatkan akan bentuk kemanusiaan dan kekuatan berekspresi untuk membantu kita menghadapi tantangan hidup yang paling besar. In the context of “**The Colors Of Grief**” in Mira’s solo exhibition, it is a form of a journey through the dimensions of grief, which results in emotional wounds, loss, and trauma. Her works are a process of life’s journey in discovering and recovering from grief, inviting you to step into a contemplative space where emotion meets art. This exhibition delves deeply into the universal human experience of suffering, exploring it through various contemporary visual arts.

Mira’s canvases paint with memories, loss, and the pain of absence. Mira’s work conveys various aspects of grief, each of which represents Mira’s transformation as an artist towards the subject. “**The Colors Of Grief**” is not a monochrome experience. It is a spectrum of emotions, each color tells its story of loss, love, and healing. Here, you’ll find a variety of artistic interpretations, from the sad ugly mournings to exuberant beginnings.

Through various mediums, Mira uses color, texture, form, and symbolism to evoke the depth and diversity of lukewarm processes. We invite you to stop momentarily, reflect, and find the color of your sadness. As you get to know Mira, you can become a catalyst for dialogue and introspection, providing space for the audience to connect with their emotions and those of others. In jumping together with Mira’s artwork, we are reminded of the form of humanitarian assistance and the power of expression to help us face life’s most significant challenges. ARTIST STATEMENT & PROFILE



ID • Merupakan wujud perjalanan panjang menemukan titik-titik dimensi luka emosional akibat kehilangan, yang disembuhkan dan diungkapkan dalam karya seni. Duka, trauma, dan kehilangan menjadi akar energi yang memicu Mira menciptakan karya untuk pameran tunggalnya ini. Karya-karyanya merupakan sebuah proses perjalanan hidup dalam menemukan dan memulihkan berbagai trauma kehilangan dan kesedihan yang ia rasakan dan alami secara eksistensial. Melalui seni lukis, ia mendapatkan kesadaran untuk menyembuhkan luka batin dan menjadi metode dalam mengelola emosi. Melalui “Lukis Jiwa” yang digagas Mira ini menjadi ruang untuk menumbuhkan kesadaran bersama akan perasaan sedih dan kehilangan sehingga kita bisa mengelola emosi ke arah yang baik.

Mira bekerja terutama dalam ruang yang intuitif dan ekspresionis, bermain dengan banyak warna, pola, dan media. Intisari dari banyak karyanya adalah pesan kesadaran bahwa kehilangan adalah bagian hidup yang harus kita terima dan waspadai. Faktanya, kita tidak dapat memiliki segalanya, kita tidak memiliki apa pun di dunia ini, lebih dalam lagi, kita tidak memiliki diri kita sendiri. Yang bisa dilakukan hanyalah merasakan duka kehilangan dengan kesadaran penuh dan pasrah, berusaha merelakan maka semesta akan menjalankan tugasnya.

EN • is a manifestation of a long journey in finding the dimensional points of emotional wounds of loss, which are healed and expressed in works of art. Grief, trauma, and loss are the roots of energy that trigger Mira to create the artworks for this solo exhibition. Her works are a process of life's journey in discovering and recovering from the many traumas of loss and sadness she felt and experienced existentially. Through painting, she gains awareness of healing inner wounds and becomes a method of managing emotions. Through "soul painting," which was initiated by Mira, it becomes a space to foster mutual awareness of feelings of sadness and loss so that we can manage our emotions in a good direction.

Mira works mainly in an intuitive, expressionistic space, playing with many colors, patterns, and media. The essence of many of her works is the message of awareness that mourn is a part of life that we must accept and be aware of. We can't have everything in fact, we don't have anything in this world, even more deeply, we don't have ourselves. What can only be done is to feel the sorrow of loss with full awareness and surrender, trying to let go then the universe will carry out its duties.

ARTIST PROFILE

Mira El Amir is an **Intuitive Painter**, who aims to explore aspects of the inner self through art. **Her art is about inner world, a spiritual healing for mind, body and soul.** She utilises emotions, thought, grief and imaginations as materials to work with in order to communicate and create connection to the subconscious world. **She believe in beauty through confusion and truth through collision.**

The abstract in her work are shaped in meaningful strokes and a visible attempt of blending with nature. She graduated from **Fashion Design** at **ESMOD Jakarta** and **Multimedia Design** at **Raffles College** in **Beijing, China**. Mira began her career in fashion and video art. Mira currently focuses her artwork in canvas, The medium of painting has always been a therapy for her and has been actively giving workshops in collaboration with therapist about art healing called **#LukisJiwa**


