3. Coffeepot spout is upside down
4. Barbed wire in place of clothesline
5. Insignia is on back of fireman's helmet instead of front
6. Green and red lights are reversed on ship's lantern
7. One cup is not hanging by its handle
8. Electric bulbs are growing on plant
9. Man's bust has head of little girl
10. Chipmunk sports rat's tail
11. Pen holder has pencil eraser
12. Top of brass vase is suspender in air
13. Clock face is a man's face
14. Candle is where kerosene lamp should be
15. Sampler is dated 1216
16. Winter scene is seen through left window, summer scene through right window
17. Antique dealer's head is on dolls
18. Nine branches on traditionally seven branched candelabrum
19. Beast, looks like a cougar, is crouched on top shelf
20. Girl's hair is loose on one side, in braided pigtail on other side
21. Titles on books read vertically instead of horizontally
22. Girl's sweater is buttoned the wrong way
23. Mouthpiece is shown on both ends of phone
24. Phone is not connected
25. Goat's head shows deer's antlers
26. No shelf to support books
27. Lace cuff on shopkeeper's shirt
28. Five fingers and one thumb on girl's left hand
29. Gun's barrel is in wrong place
30. Saddle is on the goat
31. Potted plant is on top of lighted stove
32. Girl's purse is a book
33. Girl's purse only has half a strap
34. Skunk is in girl's arms
35. Sea gull has crane legs
36. Stovepipe is missing from stove
37. Mona Lisa has a halo
38. Mona Lisa is also facing the wrong way\*
39. Abraham Lincoln is wearing General Grant's military coat
40. Stove has April Fool imprinted on it\*
41. Doll has hooves instead of feet
42. Little girl is sitting on air
43. Roger's group is combination of soldier from "Our Hero" and girl from "Blushing Bride"
44. Brass kettle sports two spouts
45. Antique dealer wears spur on one shoe
46. Mouse is conferring with ground mole
47. Ground mole's track through wooden floor
48. Dog's head is on cat's body
49. Raccoon's tail is on cat's body
50. Ball fringe is standing straight up at an angle
51. Stove is missing one leg
52. These are two different kinds of flooring
53. Norman Rockwell signature is reversed\*
54. Rockwell is misspelled Rockwoll
55. Flowers are growing in floor
56. Girl's socks do not match
57. Girl's shoes do not match
