A month after graduating from Mississippi State University Ms. Conn joined the T.K. Martin Center as the Art Coordinator for the Express Yourself! Art Program in August 2020. Her knowledge of multiple art disciplines helps her to instruct 8 - 14 Wednesday Art Class Students ages 6 - 12, 40 Project Impact Preschool Students ages 3 - 12, and 6 Express Yourself! Artists ages 9 – 48 on painting, drawing, and ceramics in the Express Yourself! Art Program. Took portraits and candid shots for all and 8 programs at the center and posted a collection of videos in conjunction with an individual with disabilities to YouTube. Edited shots in iMovie and Premier. Managed the T.K. Martin website though the university, social media accounts (Instagram and Facebook - @t.k.martincenter Twitter - @tkmartincenter) replied to message requests, and created content for those accounts. Organized an Art Auction for the sale of 4 Express Yourself! artists work, which raised nearly \$5,000.
