After the ceremony, you'll enjoy lunch in a tranquil setting at a riverfront restaurant. The next stop is Nkyinkyim, an outdoor museum and art space that showcases Ghana's history and cultural stories through sculpture and installations.

You'll return to Accra in the late afternoon, where a private African theater performance awaits, offering an immersive experience of traditional storytelling and dance.

DAY 3- CHOCOLATE TASTING & DAY AS YOU PLEASE

This will be followed by a delicious lunch at a contemporary West African restaurant in the city, after which you have the rest of the day at your leisure.

DAY 4 - HERITAGE & HISTORY OF THE ENSLAVED

Your day starts with an early pick-up for a scenic drive to Cape Coast. Upon arrival, you'll visit Global Mamas, where you'll participate in a batik-making class, designing your own fabric using traditional techniques—a unique keepsake of your journey.

After lunch, the afternoon takes a reflective turn with private guided tours of Cape Coast and Elmina Castles, led by an African history expert.

These UNESCO World Heritage sites offer a solemn look at the transatlantic slave trade, with visits to the dungeons, holding cells, and the "Door of No Return," providing a deep understanding of this historical tragedy.

DAY 5 - KAKUM NATIONAL PARK & JOURNEY TO KUMASI

The day begins with a scenic drive to Kakum National Park, where you'll experience the famous Canopy Walkway suspended high above the rainforest. A park guide will lead you through this lush ecosystem, sharing insights into the local wildlife and plant species.

Continuing north, you'll stop at Assin Manso, a historically significant site linked to the transatlantic slave trade. Here, you'll visit the Slave River and the Ancestral Burial Ground, where repatriated ancestors were laid to rest.

Upon arrival in Kumasi, the cultural capital of the Ashanti Kingdom, you'll embark on a Kumasi City Tour, including a visit to the Manhyia Palace Museum, which showcases the history and legacy of the Ashanti monarchy.

DAY 6 - AN ASANTE HERITAGE

Your day in Kumasi begins with a visit to the craft villages of Ntonso, Ahwiaa, and Adanwomase, where you'll witness traditional weaving, carving, and dyeing techniques that have been passed down through generations.

Next, you'll visit the Asante Traditional Buildings, UNESCO-listed sites that showcase the architectural heritage of the Ashanti Kingdom. You'll also have the opportunity to meet the renowned royal umbrella makers

Enjoy a scenic drive back to Accra and check into your hotel.

Our journey continues to Independence Square and the Kwame Nkrumah Memorial Park (KNMP), two landmarks of Ghana's political history. Later, you'll participate in a surprise experience to be revealed upon reaching the location.

The day concludes with a farewell dinner featuring a private chef, a live African band, and a memorable final evening.
