



Waway is a Datu of the Talaandig Tribe of Lantapan, Bukidnon. He is credited as the *Father of Soil Art*.


He is also an educator, sharing his musical prowess. On the leadership Aspect, he is a Councilor for the local government of his hometown.










Artist: JONG TANGIDAY


















Portrait of a Maranao Girl By: Lea Padilla 6ft x 2ft Acrylic on canvas Php 200,000



MARIO PARIAL

For an artist to have Sotheby's carry your art means you have made waves in the industry. True enough, multi-awarded painter Parial, exhibited extensively in Europe, the USA and Asia. He wore other visual arts hats like photographer, printmaker and sculptor. One of his earlier works as a printmaker is Kalikasan wherein Parial used the woodcut process - the oldest type of printmaking. Parial was born in Gapan, Nueva Ecija on Aug 13, 1944.

From the late PERDIGON VOCALAN

Vocalan was a quintessential Filipino artist who hailed from Angono, Rizal. He was a tutored by National Artist Carlos "Botong" Francisco. Vocalan's contribution to Angono goes beyond art – he opened Balaw Balaw Restaurant and Art Gallery in 1983. To this day Balaw Balaw is one of the tourists attractions of the municipality.
