1. Policy Statement

MedWaste Solutions is committed to conducting its operations in a manner that minimises environmental impact and promotes sustainability.

Although we do not directly collect, transport, or dispose of clinical waste, we play a vital role in ensuring that all waste management activities carried out on behalf of our clients are safe, compliant, and environmentally responsible.

We recognise our obligations under the Environmental Protection Agency Act 1992, the Waste Management Acts 1996–2023, and other relevant Irish and EU environmental legislation.

Our environmental objectives are to:

- Work only with licensed and environmentally responsible partners.

2. Scope

3. Responsibilities

Management:

- **Minimise Office Waste:** Encourage digital communication, recycling, and responsible use of consumables.
- **Procure Responsibly:** Source materials, equipment, and services from environmentally responsible suppliers where possible.
- **Prevent Pollution:** Ensure our staff and contractors follow safe, compliant practices to prevent contamination or spillages during site visits or coordination.
