Emergency Medical Technician - Basic

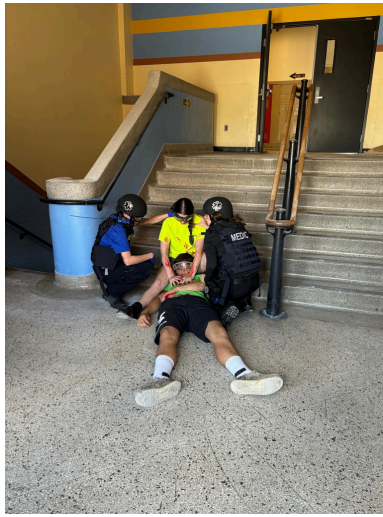

## Course Schedule

Orientation is Friday June 5<sup>th</sup> at 1800, with the academy starting on Monday June 8<sup>th</sup>. Classes are held every Monday and Wednesday from 1800-2200, every other Saturday from 0900-1800, and (2) weekend courses for PHTLS and TECC. The course duration is 17 weeks. Class will be held at the Corunna Ambulance Base and Education Center at 610 N. Shiawassee St. Corunna, MI 48817.





## Requirements

- Must be 18 years of age or older.
- High school diploma or GED.
- Valid driver's license.
- Background check.

## Tuition & Fees

The total cost of the course is \$2,500 and covers the EMT-B Academy, books & learning materials, certification fees for BLS, PEARS, PHTLS, & TECC, uniform polo, and your first attempt at the National Registry Exam. Payment plans are available. We also partner with Michigan Works for tuition assistance.
