

# **Pet Portrait Information**

Thank you for downloading this information sheet. I hope this will answer all your questions but please do not hesitate to contact me if you need any further information.

#### **Initial Contact**

Please contact me via the 'Contact Me' page on my website or via email (info@carolfrancesart.co.uk). I aim to respond within 24 hours and if you contact me during normal working hours, it's usually on the same day.



#### **Step 1 - Send Your Photos**

I work from photos (ideally digital) and to help with this, I will send you tips for taking/sourcing photos.

I realise that sometimes portraits can be memorial portraits and that good quality photos may not be available so please just send me your chosen photo(s) - I'm more than happy to work with what you have.

Please send as many photos as you like!



### Step 2- Choose Your Size

These are the things to consider when choosing which size portrait:

- The wall space you have available
- Whether you would prefer square or rectangle
- Budget (current prices are displayed on my website)
- The size of the animal for instance the smaller the animal, the smaller the drawing you might like
- Whether you just want head and shoulders or the whole animal



## Step 3 - Book Your Slot



Once we've agreed on a photo and size, I ask for a 50% booking fee to secure your pet portrait slot, with the balance payable on completion. If preferred, a £20 payment will secure a slot in my diary with the balance of the 50% payable before I start work. Payment can be made via bank transfer. At the same time, I will let you know when you can expect your portrait.



Step 4 - Drawing in Process

One week before starting your portrait I will email to let you know, and will let you know the expected completion date (normally within 2 weeks). At this point I will provide a mock-up and it's possible to change the size if you change your mind. Up until I start working on the portrait, the booking fee is refundable. Once I've started working on the portrait (including layouts/mockups) the booking fee becomes non-refundable. I'll keep you informed at all stages of the process.





Step 5 - Approval

Once the drawing is complete, I will send photos for approval and request the balance payment. Once the balance has been paid, I will post the portrait to you, or arrange collection.
