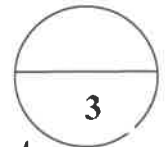

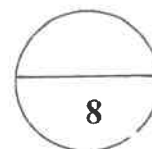

Throughout history, humans have always run. Thousands of years ago, they ran to hunt food. In the 1800s, sport became an important part of children's education. After the modern Olympics began later that century, athletes became famous. People admired them and wanted to be like them. However, until about forty years ago, watching running races was more popular than running. Now this has changed. More and more people are recognising the benefits of exercise and are putting on their running shoes!

It is a well-known fact that exercise is good for you. Studies have shown that it can help prevent many types of illnesses including heart disease and cancer. It will also help you live longer. Studies show that exercise can add up to 5 years to your life. Of course, there are many ways to exercise. Running is just one of them. But running may have advantages over other kinds of exercise. For example, one study showed that people who ran more than 80 kilometres per week had more HDL cholesterol (good fat) than people who did not run.

If you feel better after exercise, there's a good reason for it. Running makes your body release feel-good chemicals. As a result, running will cheer you up and can reduce stress levels. In fact, a study found that just 30 minutes of running each week for three weeks helped people sleep better and improved their mood.

On the other hand, there are some disadvantages of running. Many runners complain of problems with their knees. If you do not warm up and stretch properly before exercising, your muscles will ache. Running is especially risky in hot weather if people do not drink enough water.

If you're interested in running, it's important to do it properly, and these tips will help. Keep your head up. Look straight forward, not down at your feet. Relax your neck and shoulders, hold your body tall and lift your chest, as this will help you breathe more easily. If you lean forward, you will hurt your lower back.

In January 2010, the International Swimming Federation banned the high-tech suits. In two years after the ban, swimmers broke only two world records. Clearly the expensive, high-tech suits were the reason behind the faster swimming times. The suits gave some swimmers an unfair advantage.

Finally, you don't have to depend mainly on technology as learning how to swim and getting good at it is a long process that takes consistent practice and focus. 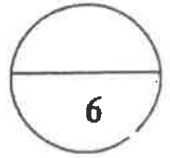

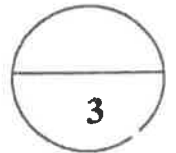
