Earthquakes are the sudden shock of the earth's surface. They are the earth's natural means of reducing pressure. It is likely to occur every year in different parts of the world. Earthquakes can be felt over large areas although they usually last less than a minute. In spite of the fact that scientists are still working on making earthquakes more controllable, no one actually can predict them!

There are about 20 layers along the surface of the earth that move continuously and slowly. When the layers squeeze, huge rocks shift with extreme force causing an earthquake. Shaking and ground breaking are the main effects created by earthquakes, mainly resulting in damage to buildings and other structures. The dangers of the effects depend on earthquake strength. Earthquakes have varied and dramatic effects such as destroying buildings damaging the man-made structures.

Most of these effects occur on ground, but, since most earthquake focuses are actually located under the ocean bottom, great effects are often observed along the sides of oceans. In fact, all governments should do their best to reduce the results of this natural disaster and save the life of both humans and animals.
