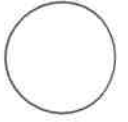

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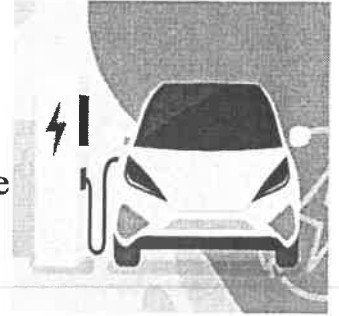

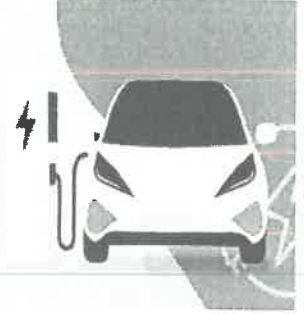

Despite their reputation for being dry empty wastelands, deserts are home to one-sixth of the world's population, and they cover over one-fifth of the Earth's landmass. Deserts can be found on every single continent, and even though they lack water, they play an important role in helping animals, humans, and the environment.



Far from being empty lands, most deserts are home to a vast group of plants and animals which have **adapted** to their harsh habitats. Besides, many of these plants and animals benefit humans. Camels in the deserts of Asia and North Africa have been used for moving from one place to another for thousands of years. Moreover, desert plants such as the dates are an important food source in North Africa and the Middle East; **they** are also one of the oldest cultivated foods in the world, dating back to thousands of years.

According to United Nations statistics, over 50 percent of world copper comes from deserts in Mexico, Australia and Chile. Other minerals and metals like gold and diamonds can be found in large quantities in the desert. Deserts are a bank of oil as they hold 75 percent of known oil reserves in the world.

We normally think of deserts to exist in hot places. There are deserts in extremely cold places, such as the Antarctic Desert and Arctic Desert. These two deserts are in fact the two largest deserts in the world. A cold desert's frozen water makes it hard for any form of life to survive. Both hot and cold deserts moderate Earth's temperature.

Far from being empty lands, most deserts are home to a vast group of plants and animals which have **adapted** to their harsh habitats. Besides, many of these plants and animals benefit humans. Camels in the deserts of Asia and North Africa have been used for moving from one place to another for thousands of years. These two deserts are in fact the two largest deserts in the world. A cold desert's frozen water makes it hard for any form of life to survive. Both hot and cold deserts moderate Earth's temperature.
