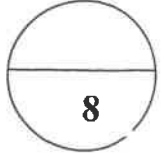

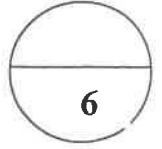

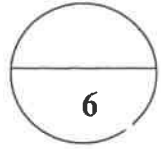

Located in the heart of the city, Al-Masjid Al-Kabir is the biggest official masjid in Kuwait, which means that official religious events are held in this masjid only. It can house up to 10,000 men in the main prayer hall and up to 1000 women in the separate hall for women. It also contains a library with Islamic reference books and documents. It is internationally renowned for its Islamic architecture, and it has become one of Kuwait's most treasured landmarks. Al-Masjid Al-Kabir's architectural style bears a resemblance to the local characteristics of the desert and the Gulf. Indeed, the builders and designers have put a lot of effort in creating this Masjid starting the project way back in 1979 and finally completing it seven years later in 1986 at a cost of about KD 14 million.

Located at the heart of the Masjid, the main prayer hall is in fact the largest hall with 4 columns. The main hall is exclusively used by male worshipers. It is 70 meters wide on all sides and has lighting provided by 144 windows with 21 wooden doors. It is elegant with natural light creeping in and also four magnificent chandeliers hanging from the roof (each weighing the same as a car). There is a 5-level car parking which can hold up to 600 cars. In Ramadan, the multi-leveled park is made clean, carpeted and air conditioned for worshipers. It is used as prayer halls to provide accommodation for them.

Muslim visitors can visit the Masjid every weekday morning at 9.00 am and can have a guided tour free of charge. Visitors will find out many facts and figures about the building and the Islamic way of life. The colour scheme is blue and beige- taken from the colours of the surroundings, which is very pleasant and soothing to the eye, particularly for those night worshipers. Its dome is decorated with Asma Al-hosna of Allah. These words were written and designed by Hamid Haddad who is one of the most important calligraphers in the Middle East.

When most people decide to buy food, they go to a grocery store. A grocery store is a retail store that sells food. The person who controls a grocery store is called a grocer. There are a range of different types and sizes of grocery stores. Some are small community stores with a limited range of items. Other grocery stores are large with vast selection of food items. Grocery stores sell many different kinds of food in just one store. They may also sell household cleaning and laundry supplies and hygiene items like soap and toothpaste. They may also contain a pharmacy. Some grocery stores also carry household goods such as aluminum foil and cleaning supplies. A grocery store is a **convenient** place to shop for the kitchen tools and beyond.

Despite the ease of shopping in a grocery store, some people decide to buy their food from other places. Farmers' markets are one alternative to grocery stores. At a farmers' market, local farmers sell the foods they grow to customers. The foods **they** sell often include fresh fruits, vegetables, and meats. Most of these foods are freshly harvested with no artificial additions. There are several ways in which farmers' markets are less appropriate than grocery stores, however. For example, many farmers do not accept credit cards or checks as payment for their goods. What is more, most farmers' markets are only open for business once or twice each week. While this often prevents some shoppers, others are willing to accept these difficulties in exchange for the fresh and local food found at farmers' market.

Deciding whether to shop for food at grocery stores or at farmers' markets is a personal choice. This choice reflects a person's values about life and about food.
