On "Days" as Sandy, the shapely Miss Roylance is

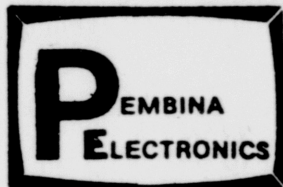
slated to become romantically involved with the wealthy, but unlucky in love, Tony DiMera.
