Domaine Henri Cruchon



Champagne Grand Cru

White • Chasselas • Dry • Light bodied • 2024 • 12.2% • 75cl • AOC La Côte

This Chasselas impresses with an unusual density of fruit for this grape variety. Its profile is powerful with generous citrus notes. Nose: Lemony, flinty minerality, long and crisp finish. Pairing: appetizer, cheeses, raclette/fondue

Domaine Henri Cruchon



Mont de Vaux Grand Cru

White • Chasselas • Dry • Light bodied • 2024 • 12.1% • 75cl • AOC La Côte

An old-fashioned Chasselas, aged on its lees, unfiltered, just as nature intended. Its personality is so pronounced that it seems atypical. An intense concentration of aromas, hints of warm stones, and an endless finish. Demeter certified.

- Nose: Notes of dried fruit, candied citrus, light saline minerality
- Pairing: Appetizer, Cheeses, Raclette/fondue, Fish

Domaine Henri Cruchon



Noblesse de Chardonnay Grand Cru

White • Chardonnay • Dry • Light bodied • 2023 • 13.8% • 75cl • AOC La Côte

A Chardonnay for fine dining: aged for 18 months, including 10 months in oak barrels, it stands out for its power, precision, and complexity. Enjoy it young or after several years of aging, as time will only further enrich its complexity.

- Nose: Candied citrus fruits, truffles, marzipan.
- Pairing: white meat, mushrooms, fish, seafood

Le Cruchon

Red • Pinot Noir • Dry • Medium bodied • 2024 • 13.0% • 75cl • AOC La Côte

A fruity Pinot Noir, without barrel aging. Refined and elegant. Best enjoyed young.

- Nose: Small red berries, mild spices, supple tannins.
- Pairing: appetizer, red meat, beef bourguignon

Domaine Henri Cruchon



Servagnin Grand Cru

Red • Pinot Noir • Dry • Full bodied • 2023 • 13.7% • 75cl • AOC La Côte

Servagnin grapes were first cultivated in the Morges region in 1420. This makes it the oldest Pinot Noir in Switzerland. Unparalleled in its deliciousness, it is instantly captivating. It is a powerful Pinot Noir with a deep color.

- Nose : offers notes of bramble, undergrowth, and red fruit.
- Palate: structured, full-bodied, and supported by a vibrant acidity.
- Pairing: grilled meats, red meat, white meat, mushrooms, beef bourguignon

Merlot

Red • Merlot • Dry • Medium bodied • 2023 • 13.8% • 75cl • AOC La Côte

Merlot thrives in heavy, clay soils, so we have chosen our most clay-rich terroirs for this grape variety. The result is a Merlot that combines power, complexity, and elegance.

- Nose: Cigar box, black fruit, toasted notes.
- Pairing: Singapore Bakwa, grilled meats, red meat, burgers, mushrooms, game

Coeur de Cuvée



Sparkling white • Chardonnay Blanc de Blanc • Brut • 2022 • 12.3% • 75cl • AOC La Côte

Produced in the pure Champagne tradition, our Coeur de cuvée will delight all lovers of sparkling wine. A 100% Chardonnay blanc de blancs. The 2nd fermentation takes place at the estate without the addition of sugar, using only the wine's own grape juice. This is followed by three years of aging on slats, which give it its full aromatic complexity.

- Nose: Brioche, a slight hint of hazelnut, a touch of lemon, and a hint of yeast.
- Pairing: appetizer, white meat, cheeses, risotto, seafood, sushi

La Colombe



White • Chasselas • Dry • Light bodied • 2024 • 12.0% • 75cl • AOC La Côte

La Colombe is the winery's traditional blend from carefully selected grapes grown in several of the Féchy area vineyards. To respect each terroir, the grapes are vinified separately and raised on lees. In the spring, the different wines are blended, giving birth to a wine that is gourmet yet dense. This is a wine that drives conversations, with the first sip leading on to others.

- Pairing: Aperitifs, chicken, grilled fish, seafood, sushi, cheese.

Domaine La Colombe

Bayel Grand Cru



White • Chasselas • Dry • Light bodied • 2024 • 12.5% • 75cl • AOC La Côte

Bayel is the name of a hillside in Féchy, with a clay, silt and siliceous moraine soil; it allows for good drainage and air flow. The low yield of these vines, which are 25 to 50 years old, leads to full expression of the exceptional character of this terroir. A wine of great purity, an expression that soars and yet remains delicate.

- Note: Yellow dress with green highlights. Fresh nose on flowers and citrus. Passed a fresh and supple attack, the wine unfolds on a nice acidity, which brings finesse and freshness. Long fruity, elegant finish.

Domaine La Colombe



Colombe Noire Réserve

Red • Pinot Noir • Dry • Medium bodied • 2022 • 13.0% • 75cl • AOC La Côte

This age-worthy Pinot Noir comes from vines fifty years old and over. After a long maceration (more than 20 days), the wine is aged entirely in barrels or casks for 12 to 18 months. A delicate wine with great character, offering aromas of small red fruits, rose petals, and cherry.

- Pairing: roasted poultry, grilled vegetables, mushroom dishes, or soft cheeses.

Domaine du Daley



Chasselas Tradition Grand Cru de Vilette

White • Chasselas • Dry • Light bodied • 2024 • 11.2% • 75cl • AOC Lavaux

A fine and delicate wine with a lovely mineral character, lively, with a delicate touch of citrus fruits and apples, matured in a tun for 10 to 11 months.

Domaine du Daley



Chasselas Réserve Grand Cru de Vilette

White • Chasselas • Dry • Light bodied • 2024 • 11.3% • 75cl • AOC Lavaux

An excellent and powerful wine with a lovely mineral character, coming partly from old vines with small yields, tight structure, a lovely expression of fresh fruits matured for 12 months in a tun.

Domaine du Daley



Gama Nera Tradition

Red • Merlot, Gamaret, Syrah • Dry • Medium bodied • 2023 • 13.3% • 75cl • AOC Lavaux

Blend of Gamaret and Cabernet Franc, powerful wine in aromas, spicy, but with very fine tannins, it is aged 15 months in casks and barrels of 3rd wine, unfiltered.

Domaine Monachon



St-Saphorin Les Manchettes

White • Chasselas • Dry • Light bodied • 2024 • 12.3% • 70cl • AOC Lavaux

Pale yellow. Initially somewhat restrained on the nose, then savoury notes, toast, melon, yellow peaches. Soft, round attack. On the palate, juicy acidity, mineral, citrus, white pepper, fresh herbs. Fresh, with a long finish. Very attractive wine that develops nicely in the glass.

Domaine Monachon



Dézaley 'Les Côtes-Dessus' Grand Cru

White • Chasselas • Dry • Light bodied • 2024 • 13.0% • 70cl • AOC Lavaux

Fresh, pleasantly subtle nose. Lemon, apple, subtle lime blossom, mineral notes. Appears subtle and elegant. Beautiful fullness on the palate, with notes of light stone fruit and a ripe, beautifully integrated acidity. Medium-long finish with mineral and citrus notes. Grippy.

Domaine Monachon



St-Saphorin Pinot Noir

Red • Pinot Noir • Dry • Medium bodied • 2024 • 13.3% • 70cl • AOC Lavaux

It offers earthy notes, red fruit (cherry/raspberry), spice, and minerality, with reviewers praising its balance and expression of terroir. Expect a classic, perhaps slightly rugged, Pinot Noir often enjoyed with meat.

Domaine Monachon



St-Saphorin Merlot

Red • Merlot • Dry • Medium bodied • 2023 • 14.4% • 70cl • AOC Lavaux

Often described as a structured yet rounded wine with black fruit, spices, and well-integrated oak. Aged in barriques, it is considered a "vin de garde" (age-worthy wine) with a potential for aging.

- Pairing: red meat, game, or complex, rich dishes.

Domaine Mermetus



Blanc sans filtre

White • Chasselas • Dry • Light bodied • 2024 • 12.0% • 75cl • AOC Lavaux

A refreshing and thirst-quenching Chasselas from Villette, which reflects its spontaneous fermentation — shake it, suggests the winery, and aromas of fresh grapes are unmistakable, with some floral notes. Fruity, pleasing, and not shy!

Domaine Mermetus



Le vin du Bacouni

Red • Mondeus Noire • Dry • Medium bodied • 2024 • 11.5% • 75cl • AOC Lavaux

This wine fully demonstrates the cool, refreshing flavor characteristic of Swiss wines and their unique, complex flavor. Its intense, purplish scarlet to purple hue shines. Complex aromas of ripe fruit and violets. Well-structured, long-lasting, and pleasant on the palate. It offers excellent aging potential.

•Pairing: Game e.g. duck, deer, chamois, wild goat, pigeon, wild boar

Domaine de la Pierre Latine



L'Yvorne Chasselas Grand Cru

White • Chasselas • Dry • Light bodied • 2024 • 12.5% • 75cl • AOC Chablais

A very good Chasselas that's delicious on its own, as an aperitif, or with fish. It has a very floral nose with honeysuckle, a hint of wisteria, and a white tea character underscored by expressive notes of white peach. The texture is silky and leads to a long finish. Falstaff rating: 89 (2024)

Domaine de la Pierre Latine



Clos du Crosex Grillé Aigle Grand Cru Cuvée des Immortels (Chasselas)

White • Chasselas • Dry • Light bodied • 2024 • 12.5% • 75cl • AOC Chablais

A lovely bouquet of white flowers, dominated by honeysuckle and linden, presents a nose reminiscent of wet stones. On the palate, this wine is generous with a velvety texture that gives it volume before finishing with a very refreshing saline note.

Domaine de la Pierre Latine



Clos du Crosex Grillé Aigle Grand Cru Syrah

Red • Syrah • Dry • Full bodied • 2023 • 13.5% • 75cl • AOC Lavaux

An impressive Syrah with great power and a pronounced umami character on the palate. It offers notes of smoke, grilled meats, candied plums, and red cherries. The tannins are firm and structured, yet fine-grained, lending volume and elegance to the wine. The texture is velvety and extends into a long finish. As the wine opens up, notes of black pepper and sage emerge.

Domaine de la Pierre Latine



Mythologie Pinotissima

Red • Pinot Noir • Dry • Medium bodied • 2022 • 13.5% • 75cl • AOC Lavaux

A remarkable Pinot Noir for its complexity! It boasts a wide array of aromas, beginning with stewed strawberry and cranberry juice, followed by a range of spicy notes, abundant Bourbon vanilla, nutmeg, and a caramel character reminiscent of rum. The tannins are very fine and delicate, extending the finish while adding depth to this wine's satiny texture.

Château Maison Blanche



Yvorne Grand Cru Chasselas

White • Chasselas • Dry • Light bodied • 2024 • 12.4% • 75cl • AOC Chablais

Admirable, divine, it is dressed in a beautiful golden yellow colour and expresses itself superbly in a blossoming style which highlights its mineral tones, its aromas of lime, flint, characteristics of the exceptional terroir. With age, it takes on aromas of honey, quince and peach of adorable complexity.

- Pairing: with grilled or sauced fish, lightly spiced white meats, or cheese dishes.

Château Maison Blanche



Yvorne Grand Cru Rouge

Red • Pinot Noir, Gamay, Garanoir, Gamaret, Diolinor, Galotta • Dry • Medium bodied • 2023 • 14.1% • 75cl • AOC Chablais

This blend boasts a deep, intense red color. Crisp and fruity, it is distinguished by its grace and harmony. Tasting note: Its complex bouquet combines aromas of fresh fruit. Frank and fruity, it is supple on the palate, revealing a fine tannic structure.

- Pairing: ideal with grilled red meats, poultry, and cheeses.

Clos du Rocher



Clos du Rocher Grand Cru

White • Chasselas • Dry • Light bodied • 2024 • 12.4% • 75cl • AOC Chablais

Clear and brilliant, a beautiful golden yellow. Deep and complex with fruity notes. Full-bodied and smooth with mineral notes, combining richness, elegance, and finesse. Pairing with appetizers, starters, white meat, cheese, fish.

Clos du Rocher



Clos du Rocher Rouge Grand Cru

Red • Syrah, Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon • Dry • Medium bodied • 2023 • 14.1% • 75cl • AOC Chablais

Deep, intense red with plum highlights. Abundant and complex aromas of blackcurrant and elderflower, with peppery and cocoa notes. Structured and fleshy with dense tannins. The finish, beautifully refined, is harmonious and intense.

- Pairing with red meat, white meat, game, cheese, Mediterranean cuisine.

Cave St-Pierre (Valais)



Réserve des Administrateurs Petite Arvine

White • Petite Arvine • Dry • Light bodied • 2024 • 13.5% • 75cl • AOC Valais

Elegant and refined, this dry Petite Arvine captivates with its floral aromas, citrus notes, and a touch of salt on the finish.

- Pairing: fish and shellfish.

With its subtle bouquet of red fruit and fine supple tannins, this Pinot Noir expresses all the nuances of its terroir. Perfect with red meats and creamy cheeses.

Humagne Rouge is captivating with its aromas of blueberry, blackcurrant, and wild berries. Thanks to its lingering finish, it pairs perfectly with game and meats in sauce.

Blackout Cuvée Rouge

Red • Syrah, Diolinor • Dry • Medium bodied • 2023 • 13.9% • 75cl • AOC Valais

Intense, deep purple color, with a bouquet of black cherry and blackberry aromas. Enchanting on the palate with a long finish. It pairs wonderfully with strong cheeses, flavorful meats, or is the perfect companion for a convivial moment.

Wine Estates

Domaine Henri Cruchon, Echichens (Vaud)



Founded in 1976 by Henri Cruchon whose family winery, now run by his granddaughter Catherine Cruchon-Griggs, is lauded for its biodynamic practices - which prohibits any use of chemical products - and high-quality wines, making them synonymous with Swiss excellence.

After the previous generation was honoured as an "Icon of Swiss Wine", the new generation has now been named among the 150 best winemakers in Switzerland, according to the Gault & Millau Guide 2025.

The domain cultivates a total of sixteen different grape varieties scattered over several small plots within the vineyards of Morges. A true mosaic of vines spread amongst a landscape of envied natural beauty, each having its own terroir, microclimate and personality.

Domaine La Colombe, Féchy (Vaud)



A **Family-Owned Winery** founded by Jules Paccot, the winery has flourished under the stewardship of his son Roger and later his grandson Raymond, over in 1978. Today, the winery is managed by Laura, representing the fourth generation dedicated to preserving the family legacy.



Since 1999, Domaine La Colombe has embraced biodynamic practices, earning DEMETER certification for their vineyards. This approach emphasizes manual soil maintenance and pruning, ensuring the long-term health of the vines. The winery avoids chemical fertilizers and insecticides, opting for natural methods.

Grapes are carefully sorted by hand and transported in open containers to preserve their quality, resulting in wines that authentically reflect the unique terroir of the region

Domaine du Daley, Lutry (Vaud)



Founded in 1392, making it the oldest commercial entity in Switzerland. It sits on an historic site overlooking Lake Geneva. It is situated in the heart of the terraced vineyards of Lavaux, a UNESCO world heritage site.

We produce the finest wines according to a philosophy of quality and respect for the environment, partly organic and partly sustainable culture, we have our own way of producing the most natural wines according to vintages. We work by hand on the vines and in the cellar, with small yields and long maturation times, ranging from 11 to 22 months. All our wines are made with the grapes grown on the vines of our property, matured and bottled on the Estate. We grow 12 grape varieties on 15 hectares divided into 5 appellations, including 7 hectares situated immediately around the Estate.

Domaine Monachon, Rivaz (Vaud)



performed with an uncompromising respect for terroir, each grape variety being sourced out of the most favourable soil and microclimate.

United by blood and vines in Rivaz, Lavaux, the Monachon family has been faithfully and passionately dedicated to the vineyard and wine work for about **300 years**. On the estate's hillsides, farming is



Domaine Mermetus, Aran (Vaud)



Henri Chollet and his wife, along with son Vincent and daughter-in-law Valerie, took over this small family winery from Henri's father in 2000. Altesse, Mondeuse and Plant Robert are among the grapes the Chollets grow. In the process, they've made a name for themselves over the past 30 years as specialists of these regional, older grapes, which can be difficult to grow. All the wines are organic. Their vineyards are spread across Lavaux, known for their steep slopes, Domaine Mermetus is special, sitting at the top, with a breathtaking view of the French and Swiss Alps and the lake. Winelovers who are hikers, wanting to walk to the winery from the lake, will put in serious exercise before arriving!

Descended from winegrowers who sold their grapes to a local collective, Philippe Gex built up the Domaine de la Pierre Latine

("Latin stone") throughout the 1980s and 1990s after assuming control of his family's vineyards in 1982 and steering operations toward estate-bottling. In 2002, Philippe was able to acquire the legendary "Clos du Crosex Grille"-a 2.5-hectare monopole,

owned for 80 years by the Churchill family, within the grand cru of Aigle whose gravelly limestone terraces yield Chasselas of impressive density and complexity.

In 2019, an investment partnership with André Hoffmann -renowned environmentalist and son of Luc Hoffmann, co-founder of the World Wildlife Fund- allowed Philippe to convert fully to organic viticultural practices and to refine his non-interventionist-minded cellar work through upgraded equipment and technology.

Château Maison Blanche, Yvorne (Vaud)



In the heart of the idyllic countryside of Yvorne rises the majestic Château Maison Blanche. The planted vineyard of Château Maison Blanche covers 7.7 hectares, which today are planted with Chasselas, Savagnin Blanc and red grapes. Château Maison Blanche was rebuilt after the landslide of 1584. It has survived the centuries and has belonged to the Schenk and Rosset families since the 1930s. The wines are among the icons of Vaud.

Clos du Rocher, Yvorne (Vaud)



Clos du Rocher was born in the 19th century, when vines and well-ordered walls replaced scrub and rock. The estate was acquired in 1918 by Emile Obrist, who immediately recognised the qualities of this terroir.



He has proved it ever since, as this vineyard with its special aura has received praise from the profession, as much for its wines as for its winemakers!

Martin Suardet oversees vine monitoring as the fourth-generation winegrower.

Cave St-Pierre, Chamoson (Valais)



Cave St-Pierre is located amidst the impressive vineyard sites of Chamoson, known for its clay slate and limestone soils. The winery grows a wide range of grape varieties that impressively reflect the diversity of the Valais terroir.

In particular, this great diversity is embodied in the most famous line of the house, the *Réserve des Administrateurs*, which is created under strict quality requirements in the vineyard and cellar and includes all the classics from the Alpine region.
