What is an audio podcast, and what are the benefits?

If you're thinking about starting a podcast but are not sure whether to do audio or video, I'd recommend starting with **audio only**, especially if you're just getting started. It's simpler, more affordable, and requires less gear—just a quality mic and some basic editing tools. You don't have to worry about being on camera, setting up lighting, or editing video. Plus, it's easier for listeners to consume since they can tune in while driving, working, or doing chores. Audio helps you build trust, grow an audience, and focus on delivering your message clearly.

That said, there are a few downsides to audio-only. You'll miss out on connecting visually with your audience, which can help with engagement. It may also be a bit harder to stand out on platforms like YouTube, which prioritize video content. And without visual cues, you'll need to work a little harder to keep things interesting through tone, pacing, and content. But overall, for most beginners, audio is still a great place to start—it gets you moving without overwhelming you.

Microphone



Headphones

In-studio headphones, particularly over-the-ear ones, are highly recommended. They offer superior sound quality in the studio environment, effectively blocking out external noise. However, I strongly advise against using Bluetooth headphones, as they can introduce lag into your recording, which is undesirable. You might wonder why headphones are necessary when recording with a remote guest. The audio from the guest's speakers can inadvertently bleed into your microphone, causing unwanted echo.
