- Warm and windproof clothing (long) pants, t-shirt, fleece, down jacket, gloves, beanie, scarf, sunglasses)
- Snow protection: waterproof overpants and jacket
- Sleeping bag liner for the refuge, toiletries kit
- Backpack and picnics for the 2 days, water / hot drink min. 1L, and snacks
