History

The Kivu Coffee Farmers Cooperative (COACKI) was created in 2022 by 10 founding members, all coffee producers from the Mbinga-South grouping, in Kalehe Territory, South Kivu Province, Democratic Republic of the Congo.

COACKI currently has 276 coffee-producing members, including 94 women and 182 men, who collectively manage 451 coffee plots, covering approximately 281 hectares, of which 128.4 hectares are planted with 321,002 coffee trees. The estimated production is 802,505 kg of cherries, equivalent to about 5 containers per season. The cooperative is in the process of obtaining organic certification under the EOS, NOP, and BRA standards.

COACKI is one of the few cooperatives in the region to have built a washing station without external aid, funded entirely by contributions from its founding members—a positive outcome for its development.

By making good governance a pillar of its management, COACKI aims to contribute to community development through coffee produced by its members.

Producers who deliver coffee to the cooperative's washing station will receive a higher price in the event of a profit after the sale—demonstrating the honesty and transparency of the cooperative, especially in contrast to other cooperatives operating in COACKI's area of

intervention.
