## Infrastructure

The MAJIRANE Agricultural Cooperative owns three coffee washing stations in Buchiro, Kishiji, and Rwamiko. The main washing station is located in Buchiro, in the Mbinga-North grouping, Kalehe Territory, South Kivu Province. It is equipped with a depulping machine, fermentation tanks, a grading channel, and more than 20 drying tables. Majirane participated in Best of Congo Cooperatives 2024 and sold 1,500 kg to Pact Coffee.
