Founded in 2019, the coop currently has 578 members, including 197 women. "United we stand, coffee is life" is the slogan under which the Tuinuwane Agricultural Cooperative was founded, with the following objectives:

- To promote the socio-economic and technical development of coffee-growing farmers;
- To relaunch and enhance the value of coffee growing;
- To supply and provide agricultural inputs and training in management, processing and environmental conservation techniques;
- To increase the quality and quantity of coffee in line with market demand
- To relaunch the socio-economic life of farmers at grassroots level;

- To promote the development and love of work;
- To increase members' income by improving the quality and quantity of their coffees;
- To participate in national and international fairs and develop marketing strategies to increase the commercialization of members' coffee.
- Progressively to achieve financial autonomy for the Cooperative.

Tuinuwane Agricultural Cooperative has a washing station with an annual production capacity of one container (19,200 kilos), with the potential to produce 3 containers with the expansion of the coffee production and processing infrastructure, which is why the Cooperative is looking for other buyers. With its partner COMEQUI, the cooperative has already produced and distributed over 20,000 coffee seedlings to members, and employs over 150 young people and women during the coffee season and in seedling production.
