

DAY	ACTIVITIES
DAY 1	Departure from Delhi (Akshardham) at 12:00 AM . Reach Varanasi , hotel check-in & relax. Evening visit to Assi Ghat. Overnight stay.
DAY 2	Early morning darshan at Kashi Vishwanath Mandir . Visit Kal Bhairav Mandir & Dhanvantari Kua . Enjoy boat ride on Ganga , then breakfast. Explore local markets. Evening Ganga Aarti at Dashashwamedh Ghat . Dinner & overnight stay.
DAY 3	Explore Vishwanath Gali, shopping & authentic Banarasi food. Leisure time for culture & experiences. Evening (5-6 PM) departure back to Delhi with lot of memories.

Day 1 [Delhi- Banaras]

- Departure from Delhi (Akshardham) at 12:00 AM but reporting time is 11:50 PM
- Arrive in Varanasi the same day.
- Check in at the hotel and unwind.
- In the evening, visit Assi Ghat to soak in the serene sunset views and the spiritual aarti.
- Overnight stay at the hotel, relaxing in the calm and spiritual atmosphere of Kashi.



Day 2 [Kashi Vishwanath Temple-Day 2 Dashashwamedh Ghat]

- Begin the day early with a sacred darshan at Kashi Vishwanath Temple, experiencing the peaceful morning aura with fewer crowds.
- Proceed to Kal Bhairav Mandir, revered as the guardian deity of Kashi.
- Pause at the holy Dhanvantari Kua, believed to hold healing significance.
- Embark on a serene boat ride on the Ganga, witnessing morning rituals and the beauty of multiple ghats along the river.
- Return for breakfast and a short rest.
- Visit the Manikarnika and Harishchandra Ghats, places of deep spiritual importance.
- Explore the Gyanvapi area and narrow lanes, filled with the charm of old Banaras.
- Head towards BHU campus and discover the Bharat Kala Bhavan Museum, followed by a wholesome local lunch.
- In the evening, immerse yourself in the divine atmosphere at Dashashwamedh Ghat, where the grand Ganga Aarti fills the air with spiritual energy.
- Return to the hotel for dinner and have an overnight stay.

Day 3 [Wander, Relish & Return]

- Begin the morning at leisure, soaking in the essence of Banaras through its culture and flavors.
- Stroll through the bustling Vishwanath Gali, discovering souvenirs, sweets, and a cup of authentic Banarasi chai.
- Relish local delicacies like kachori-sabzi, seasonal malaiyyo, and refreshing lassi.
- Enjoy free time for shopping and photography at the ghats, capturing the spirit of Kashi.
- By afternoon (3–4 PM), return to the hotel, pack your bags, and prepare for departure.
- Leave for Delhi, carrying with you divine memories and the soulful aura of Varanasi.


