The Virginia Mead & Honey Festival features Virginia meaderies as well as a range of craft vendors and information booths related to mead, honey and honeybees. Attendees will be able to sample and purchase mead from attending meaderies, hear presentations from guest speakers on the topics of mead, honey and honeybees, shop at a range of craft vendors and interact with information and resource booths, and enjoy live music and food trucks.

Application Process:

1. Complete the application form on the following page in full.
2. **Vendors:** Enclose a check for \$50, payable to **Mountain Run Winery**. You can also pay online if you email us the filled application (link will be sent after receipt of application).
3. **Information Booths:** For non-profits and other related resource groups that do not wish to primarily sell any merchandise, there is no fee associated with attending this event. Limited vending is allowed at these booths. Fill out the application so that we can properly organize the event and correctly assign spaces.

You will be emailed a receipt notice which serves as your reservation. Vendors are approved on a first come, first served basis.

Space Assignments: Spaces will be located on grass and will be 15'x15' unless otherwise noted. You may request a larger space in your application and larger spaces will be accommodated based on availability. Vendors, information booths and meaderies will be interspersed in a horseshoe shape in a large field. A space assignment map will be emailed prior to the festival. Mountain Run Winery reserves the right to modify space assignments as may be required. All spaces are accessible for setup beginning after 9:00 AM. We cannot guarantee vehicle accessibility directly beside spaces though most should be either directly beside or very closely accessible by vehicle for setup. All vendors/booths must be set-up with vehicles removed from festival area by 11:30 am.

Vendor Check-In: Vendor/Booth check-in starts at 9:00 am. There will be a check-in table when you arrive on the morning of the festival that will help you find your spot and show you where vendor parking is.

Unless specifically requested in the application below, vendors are responsible for their own tables and/or tents, chairs, merchandise, and displays. Tents are not required but any tents must be securely **tied & staked** down in the event of strong wind. Please do not leave behind any garbage or refuse at your space.

Other information:

- ☐ We expect that vendors/booths will make at least one social media post about their participation.
- ☐ If you wish to sample the meads at the event, you may purchase a tasting glass (allows free samples at all participating meaderies) for \$20/person at check-in. Cash payment at check-in is preferred.
- ☐ There is no WiFi or electricity for vendors at this event. We do have a strong local LTE/cellphone network
- ☐ There is optional **camping** onsite. Please contact Mountain Run Winery if you wish to camp before or after the festival.
- ☐ There is no rain date in the case of inclement weather.
- ☐ You assume all risk associated with your attendance at and participation in this event.
