## AHAS KIRKHS BACKGROUND

AHAS KIRKHS was first established as the CENTRE FOR FUNDAMENTAL KNOWLEDGE (CFK) in July 1983.

With the objective of providing courses in Revealed Knowledge, in line with the Islamization and Integration of the University Curriculum.

The Centre was upgraded to become the Kulliyyah of in 1990. Initially, CFK became the Department of Islamic Revealed Knowledge and Heritage, which was then further developed into 4 new departments in December 1996 (Usul al-Din and Comparative Religion, Qur'an and Sunnah Studies, Figh & Usul al-Figh, and General Studies).

Eight Human Sciences departments were established at the same time which includes Arabic Language and Literature, English Language and Literature, Communication, History, Psychology, Political Science, Sociology and Anthropology, Philosophy, and Library/Information Science.





We offer a four-year full-time programme of studies leading to the Bachelor of Human Sciences with Honours in Psychology, and postgraduate degrees at the Master and Ph.D. levels. #### SOCIOLOGY AND ANTHROPOLOGY
