



PATCH TEST CONSENT & ACKNOWLEDGMENT

Patch testing involves applying a small amount of pigment or serum to the skin and securing it in place for approximately 48–72 hours. The test area will be monitored for any signs of irritation or reaction. Possible adverse reactions may include localized redness, rash, itching, infection, or delayed skin sensitivity.

Although uncommon, allergic reactions to pigments are possible. Pigments or serums ingredients may include iron oxide, titanium dioxide, isopropyl alcohol, glycerin, ethanol, and distilled water.

A patch test is recommended as a precaution; however, it does not guarantee that an allergic or adverse reaction will not occur during or after a tattoo or permanent makeup procedure.
