## TRENITALIA & ITALO TRAIN PROMO FARES

Book in advance to enjoy Super Economy or Low Cost train tickets between major cities like Rome, Florence, and Milan.

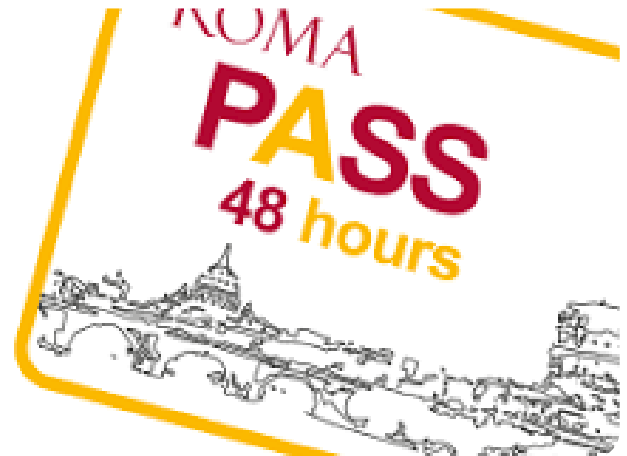

## VENICE VAPORETTA (WATER BUS) TRAVEL CARD

Save on Venice's pricey transport by getting a 1–7 day ACTV pass. Includes unlimited rides on all vaporettos and buses.

## ROMA PASS

Get free skip-the-line entry to top attractions like the Colosseum, discounts for others, and unlimited metro/bus use.

## FLORENCE CITY PASS – FREE MUSEUM ENTRY

Includes priority access to Uffizi, Accademia (Michelangelo's David), and other top sites. Combo deals also include Hop-on Hop-off buses. Online prices start around €50.

## FREE MUSEUM SUNDAYS

On the first Sunday of every month, state-run museums and archaeological sites across Italy (like Pompeii, Colosseum, Uffizi) are free to enter.

## MONEY SAVING HACKS

### Travel During Shoulder Season

Traveling during the shoulder season (spring or autumn) means cheaper flights, lower hotel rates, and fewer crowds at tourist attractions. For Europe, that's usually April–May and September–October. You'll still enjoy good weather but save big on expenses.

### Use Local SIM Cards or eSIMs

Buy a local SIM card or install an eSIM (like Airalo or Holafly) for affordable data and calls. It's often way cheaper than using international roaming from your home provider and helps you use maps, translation apps, and ride services with ease.
