Dear Prayer Partners:

We continue to receive good news of God's blessings from the field; as always, it is a joy to be able to share some of them with you, our co-laborers.

Between August and November, El Camino Baptist Church in Tijuana has seen many make professions of faith and 32 baptized. Classes for the Christian schools began in August; there were 350 enrolled in the Mexican school, 100 in the American school, and 40 in the Bible Institute.

On September 15th the church observed the 16th, Mexico's Independence Day, with 910 attending. They had dinner on the ground with over 40 typical Mexican dishes served. In October they held their annual missions conference, with 4 missionaries attending. As a result, their mission giving increased enough to add 10 new missionaries to their missions program. The church has broken ground for an addition to the auditorium. It will measure approximately 50x72 feet, allowing for much needed additional seating.

I received word from Bro. Omar Avila, our graduate that has a church planted in Zamora, Michoacán. They have a couple in their church that recently lost their 8 month old baby to Leukemia. There were near 200 in attendance of the funeral, and numerous professions of faith were made. There are 12 new folks now attending the church as a result.

Thank you for the vital part that you have in the Lord's blessings on all of the ministries at El Camino and that have been established by graduates of the Bible Institute. And thank you for your faithful prayers and support for Jeanie and myself.
