I was blessed to be a part of the Home Missions program of the last church Daisey and I helped the Lord to start in Manaus, the capital of Amazonas. I also got to visit and speak in the school for the children of lepers. On the last day I was asked to speak at the closing ceremony for Onase, better known in the states as Awana. What a blessing to see how the churches in the state of Amazonas are on missions at home and around the world. Manaus has become the seventh richest city in Brazil and has increased in population.

Christmas was everywhere to be seen, and I could not help but speak on the subject. Isaiah 7:14 we read, "Behold a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel." We know that Immanuel means "God with us," and is a sign of the virgin birth. This was biologically impossible without a divine miracle of creation.
