## A DIVINE PROMISE

Because God's people prayed, our first fifteen years in Honduras produced three churches. The Lord then said, "an hundred fold", Mat. 13:23, indicating churches, and reiterated his promise some thirty years later.

A twice weekly radio program broadcast on seventy stations expanded our outreach to eleven countries. One result was pastors enrolling their churches as seminary extensions. Their workers with accredited degrees strengthen their ministry and establish new churches.

In 2012 the Lord said, "You have finished the work I gave you to do," then directed us to relocate to North Carolina. We left confident that he would sustain the churches established since our ministry began forty-four years earlier.

Two months after arriving the pastor of a Hispanic church asked me to renew the seminary classes he had cancelled. Two years later a second pastor asked to have classes in his church also.

Those classes inspired Pastor Fernando Montt, a native Columbian, to establish a virtual seminary taught by professors with advanced degrees. At his request in 2021 we co-founded and accredited Seminario Bautista Logos. To date 114 students from fifteen countries attend classes.

On the field the indigenous churches continue to be established as dedicated pastors teach faithful men, 2 Tim. 2:2. Each new church means souls saved and disciples being baptized.


We have always taught and shown the national believers that God can work miracles through them. Their zealous dedication has resulted in fiftytwo churches in four countries increasing to eighty-eight in eleven countries since our departure.

The Apostle Paul's method of missionary service is the only one inspired of the Holy Spirit. Our bountiful harvest confirms it is just as viable today as it was in the early church.

Our pastor, Bobby Helms, asked for the map to be developed for the brethren to see on a 4 X 2 ½ foot poster what God can do. It also enables mission supporting churches and believers to rejoice as he accomplishes his miraculous works through unworthy servants.
