Dear Prayer Partners and Co-Laborers,

This first year of deputation has brought fast-paced learning, new experiences, many miles of traveling, and the blessing of meeting so many brethren that it is difficult to keep up with.

As previously mentioned, I didn't come from a family of missionaries. God has been preparing us in ways and for many years before we were aware of His plan for our lives. I know that our sovereign heavenly Father has not been surprised by any of these things because He has already seen and He already knows what He will do. I, on the other hand, have not seen nor do I know what all He will do. Sometimes I don't even know what I am doing. But God uses our flaws, our faults, our imperfections to His perfect will in His perfect timing.

I have been able to travel to Mexico twice, one flight and once by ground, and I was blessed to be able to preach in Los Lirios on both occasions. (disclaimer, I had an interpreter because *Todavía estoy aprendiendo* I am still learning) Thousands of miles of driving, nearly 2 dozen churches, hundreds of people that we have met and fellowshiped with in just this short amount of time. God has blessed us through it all.

If anyone would have asked about my plans for the future before God called us into this ministry, I know we would still be serving. We love serving in our church and with our people. But my vision would have been so far short of what God has opened up for us. People have moved to foreign soil for their career, for family and for education. God has called people for reasons that He alone knows. We will gladly follow God as He draws us to Mexico because God always has a plan and He is the strength, guidance and wisdom to carry out the plan.

We have been busy focusing on scheduling meetings, travel and presenting the ministry, while Crystal is still teaching our girls and I still (for now) am working a full-time job. Life and death have continued for us as I am sure it has for some of you as well. Our family has experienced the death of three loved ones this year. We have been comforted by God's word where He inspired Paul to write to the Thessalonians *that ye sorrow not, even as others which have no hope...* This passage is great comfort for believers that because *Jesus died and rose again, even so them also which sleep in Jesus will God bring with him.* What comfort that, even though we mourn the loss of our loved ones here and now, we will see them again when we meet the Lord *...and so shall we ever be with the Lord.* Our hearts are broken for the lost who do not yet have this hope. We shall continue to bring this hope, this joy which was brought to us. This great salvation which brings *good tidings of great joy which shall be to all people.*

We are grateful for all of you who have poured into us and been praying for us. We are grateful also for those who have been led to financially support us as we endeavor to carry the Gospel to the people of Mexico.
