Dear Co-laborers,

During the first two months of 2026, I have had the privilege of teaching in four different locations in Indonesia. My first opportunity was to speak to our ladies at our National Fellowship Meeting in Pontianak, Kalimantan. I was asked to teach on *The Pastor's Wife*. Since I am not a pastor's wife, I sought the advice of at least ten different women who have been wives of pastors for at least ten years. Those attending responded very well to the lesson, and one pastor's wife has even started a WhatsApp group just for wives of pastors. Each day she sends a devotion to the group.



On January 31st, I held a Vacation Bible School workshop for Macedonia Baptist Church in Cengkareng, Jakarta. Their VBS theme this year will be *Big Fish Bay* with lessons taken from the life of Jonah. During the workshop, all the VBS songs were taught and sung, lessons explained and handed out to the teachers, games were taught and played, and a sample craft was made for each day. Macedonia is planning to hold their VBS March 18-22, when the children are on break from school for the Islamic holiday, Idul Fitri. Please pray that it will go well, and that they will have good attendance.

On February 2nd, a new semester began at our Bible college in Jakarta. This semester I am teaching *Sunday School 101* and *Visual Aids* on Monday nights. I have eight students, many of whom are from several different islands of Indonesia. Please pray that they will learn to become faithful Sunday School teachers and church workers.



On February 5th and 6th, I held a Sunday School Teacher Seminar for Renon Baptist Church in Bali. The sessions included *The Joys of Teaching Sunday School*, *How to Teach a Life Changing Lesson*, *Music in the Sunday School*, *Leading a Child to Christ*, *Visual Aids*, and *Managing Your Classroom*. The sixteen attendees were attentive, asked many questions, and were a delight to teach. Please pray the Lord will use them to reach many boys and girls on the islands of Bali and Sumba.

Thank you so very much for your continued prayers and faithful support which make it possible for me to teach and train others throughout Indonesia.
