Also, this church is now the owner of the radio station, "Voice Of The Good Shepherd". They are negotiating with BBN to be a relay point to the folks in the rest of the western villages.

There are shadows of darkness that surrounds all Latin America! More light is needed. A small lit candle could become a great lighthouse with your prayers.
